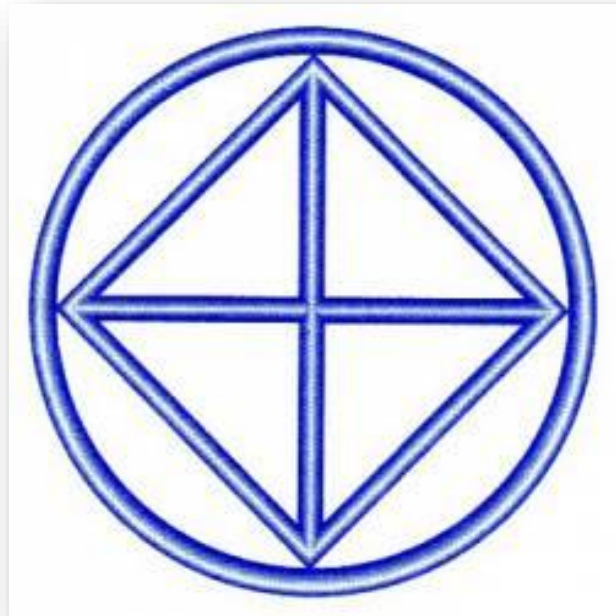

Dhanishta Foundation Annual Report 2024-25

Dhanishta expended Rs.1.08 Crores during the financial year 2024-25 for various charitable activities with the funds flowing in from patrons, charity lovers, and other like-minded people. This year Dhanishta received Rs. 73.38 lakhs through donations and Rs. 66.92 lakhs through the interest on Fixed deposits and other income. Briefly, the charitable activities are enumerated here under

Andari Talli Annadanam Project –

According to the scriptures, offering food to the hungry and needy is among the highest forms of virtue. Guided by this sacred principle, Dhanishta has been steadfast in conducting this noble service with deep veneration and compassion. With love and respect for those less fortunate, many of whom may not receive even a single meal a day, Dhanishta continues to serve selflessly, upholding the timeless values of kindness and generosity.

✚ Inspired by our beloved Master K. Parvathi Kumar, the *Andari Talli Annadanam Project* was initiated in the sacred memory of our revered Founder Chairperson, Smt. K. Krishna Kumari garu. Conceived in 2020 as a unique and heartfelt initiative, this project aims to distribute food daily on a large scale to the destitute and hungry. Through this noble effort, we continue to uphold the spirit of unconditional service and compassion, offering sustenance and dignity to those in need.



Since its inception, Dhanishta has been distributing free meals every day to around 250 individuals—many of whom take shelter near holy places, on footpaths, and in other vulnerable locations. These

individuals wait with hope and gratitude to receive their daily meal, lovingly served by our tireless, devoted, and selfless volunteers who embody the spirit of service through the *Andari Talli Annadanam Project*.

- ✚ Under the able guidance of Sri Ram Prasad Joshi Garu, Bengaluru Brotherhood distributed food, and groceries required to the institutions on various occasions at different places based on need and on request at Old age homes, Gurukulams and also at Temples.



- ✚ Food is also distributed in the schools run for differently abled children and also in institutions where Vedic education is imparted.
- ✚ On the occasion of the birthday of Mother Smt K Krishna Kumari garu food was distributed to the 650 devotees at Sri Prasanna Anjaneya Swamy Temple, Nagaluru under the guidance of Sri R P Joshi garu.



During the year Dhanishta Foundation has expended Rs. 36,52,096/- for the food distribution.

Adarna – Women Welfare –

This is a women's welfare initiative conceived to support financially distressed women and children. The core objective of the program is to empower women to become self-reliant and capable of supporting their families. To achieve this, vocational training is provided at *Master EK Samskrithi Sadan* in various skills such as tailoring, mehendi design, and other income-generating activities. Through this initiative, women are given the tools and confidence to build a better future for themselves and their loved ones.



Dhanishta has expended Rs. 2,46,906/- for this program.

Educational Assistance -

Education is a powerful means to acquire knowledge and evolve in today's fast-paced world. Recognizing this, Dhanishta extends its support to deserving students who exhibit merit but face financial constraints in pursuing their education. Through this initiative, students from various educational levels—from elementary school to post-graduation—are given the opportunity to learn and grow.

Dhanishta provides assistance to students across several cities, including Anantapur, Rajahmundry, Srikakulam, Vizianagaram, Hyderabad, Vijayawada, Bengaluru, Mysuru, and Visakhapatnam. Support is offered not only based on academic merit but also in recognition of students' involvement in extracurricular activities, nurturing both their intellect and holistic development.

During the year Dhanishta Foundation expended Rs. 20,67,506/- towards this cause and the total number of students who received the assistance is around 200 from various places. Details of assistance provided are as under:

- ✚ As part of its educational support initiative, Dhanishta provides assistance to 8 students in Bengaluru and Mysuru, currently pursuing studies from 8th standard up to graduation. These students have demonstrated outstanding academic performance in their respective schools and colleges, making them deserving recipients of this support.
- ✚ Based on their merits the assistance is provided to 32 students whose academics range from Pre-school to engineering in Visakhapatnam from various schools and colleges.
- ✚ 10 students were given cash prizes along with a memento studying 8th, 9th and 10th standard at Sri Shailandra Vidya Mandir, Karnataka.



- ✚ 9 students were given cash prizes along with a memento studying 8th, 9th and 10th standard at Pragna Bharathi Vidyalaya, Karnataka.
- ✚ 9 students were given cash prizes along with a memento studying 8th, 9th and 10th standard at Government High School, Devalpura, Mysuru.
- ✚ 9 students were given cash prizes along with a memento studying 8th, 9th and 10th standard at Government High School, Hadinaru, Mysuru
- ✚ 9 students were given cash prizes along with a memento studying 8th, 9th and 10th standard at Sri Chinmaya Grameena Vidyalaya, Chokkahalli.

- ✚ 9 students were given cash prizes along with a memento studying 8th, 9th and 10th standard at Sri Chinmaya High School, Kolar.



- ✚ 18 students were given cash prizes along with a memento studying 8th, 9th and 10th standard at Sri Potti Sri Ramulu Municipal School and Sri Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Municipal High School of Anantapur.
- ✚ Notebooks and other stationary items were distributed to 105 students at Bala Bhanu Vidyalayam, Karempudi.



- ✚ In addition to its ongoing initiatives, Dhanishta has adopted two residential blocks at *Campus Challenge*, a specialized institution located in Poosapaturrega, Visakhapatnam. Campus Challenge is a residential school that offers academic education, vocational training, and medical support to orphans, differently-abled, and physically challenged children. Through this adoption, Dhanishta supports the care and development of 50 such children residing in these blocks.

In reverence for the unwavering service and dedication of our guiding lights, one block has been lovingly dedicated to *Ammagaru*

Smt. Krishna Kumari Garu, and the other to Smt. & Sri N. V. S. Murthy Garu. These dedications stand as a tribute to their compassion and lifelong commitment to service



Marripudi Village Project –

Marripudi is a village in proximity to Bapatla. In this village there is a temple of Lord Siva which was constructed by the ancestors of our Master K Parvathi Kumar. At this temple food is distributed to the senior citizens of the village every Monday and Thursday.

A small Gosala is also maintained by the Temple members which Dhanishta supports by providing cow fodder to the cows.



Dhanishta also provides necessary assistance to the old-age home at Ponnuru Amma Seva Nilayam run by Sri Anthony Swamy. Clothes are distributed to the senior citizens on various occasions. Stationery and clothes are also distributed to the children of the Government School at Ponnuru.

During the year Rs. 3,19,480/- was expended by Dhanishta Foundation for this project.

Assistance to senior citizens –

Old-age homes at Visakhapatnam are regularly assisted in providing food and other facilities to the poor and destitute elders regularly.

Dhanishta also assisted the Amma Seva Nilayam, Ponnuru in the reconstruction of a new building for the senior citizens.



This year Dhanishta Foundation has expended Rs. 5,40,000/- for this cause.

Animal Care & Protection –

Dhanishta Foundation also runs a *Gosala*—the “Kamadhenu Cow Shelter” at Chinna Tekkali Village, with the kind support and cooperation of Sri U. Ch. B. Varma Garu and his family, esteemed philanthropists of the village. At this shelter, 50 cows and calves are lovingly provided with nutritious fodder, proper shelter, and attentive care, reflecting the foundation’s

commitment to protecting and nurturing *Gomata*, a symbol of sacredness and sustenance in our tradition.



Furthermore, Dhanishta extends its support to the *Kamadhenu Go-samrakshana Kendram* in Rajahmundry, where dedicated members of the World Teacher Trust lovingly care for around sixty cows. As part of its ongoing commitment to *Go-seva*, Dhanishta contributes by providing essential fodder and grass on a monthly basis, ensuring the well-being and nourishment of the cows under their care.

During the year for the Protection of the Animal Kingdom Dhanishta Foundation has expended Rs. 13,47,700/-.

Wisdom Teaching and Training –

Dhanishta also conducts regular meditation sessions and training programs in ritual practices, fostering inner growth and spiritual discipline. In alignment with its mission to spread timeless knowledge, Dhanishta maintains the *Wisdom Teaching Temple*—a sacred space dedicated to imparting ancient wisdom that is universal in nature and deeply relevant to practical life. Through these efforts, seekers are guided towards a life of awareness, service, and harmony.



Rs. 7,99,940/- was expended for the Wisdom Teaching Temple by Dhanishta Foundation during this year.

Seminar Expenses –

Learning and teaching have always been integral to Dhanishta's mission. Inspired by the profound wisdom and global presence of Master K. Parvathi Kumar, who has tirelessly conducted seminars across the world, Dhanishta continues to uphold this tradition by organizing seminars that share valuable teachings with seekers both in person and through various communication channels.

Under the able guidance of Sri R. P. Joshi, seminars were held this year at *Master Mountain Resorts*, Kodanadu, aligning with significant celestial events such as the Equinoxes and Solstices. Additionally, an annual summer camp titled *SPANDANA* was organized for children aged 8 to 15 years, offering a blend of learning, values-based activities, and joyful experiences to inspire the younger generation.



For these activities, Dhanishta spent an amount of Rs. 5,07,373/-.

Self-transformation program –

“Sreem” and “Raam” are cosmic seed sounds (*Bija mantras*) representing splendor and righteousness, as revealed by the ancient seers. In reverence to these sacred vibrations, Dhanishta undertakes the noble task of printing and distributing books dedicated to the daily writing of the divine name *Sri Ram*—100 times a day. These written books are then carefully preserved at various locations across the country as a spiritual offering.

This sacred initiative is carried out in loving memory of the late Sri K. Venkatappayya Sastry Garu, a devoted practitioner of the *Sri Ram* mantra and the beloved father of our mentor, Sri K. Parvathi Kumar Garu. During the year, an amount of ₹2,69,000/- was devoted to this holy cause, reflecting Dhanishta’s unwavering commitment to sustaining and spreading spiritual practices rooted in ancient wisdom.

Medical Assistance –

Dhanishta also extends its support to individuals facing financial hardship in meeting their medical needs. The Foundation provides free medicines to the economically disadvantaged and, when necessary, assists in covering

surgical expenses. Through this initiative, Dhanishta seeks to ease the burden of medical costs and uphold the dignity and well-being of those in need.

In collaboration with Susheela Public Charitable Trust, Dhanishta organized medical camps in several villages near Nabarangpur, Odisha. Through these efforts, over 50 cataract and other eye surgeries were successfully performed, restoring full eyesight to individuals who had long suffered from visual impairment. This life-changing initiative was made possible with the dedicated support of *Simadri Surya Eye Hospital*, reflecting Dhanishta's commitment to accessible healthcare and transformative service.



This year Dhanishta expended Rs. 6,52,043/- for the cause.

Financial Assistance -

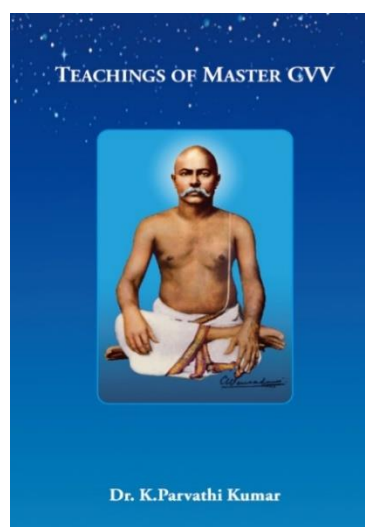
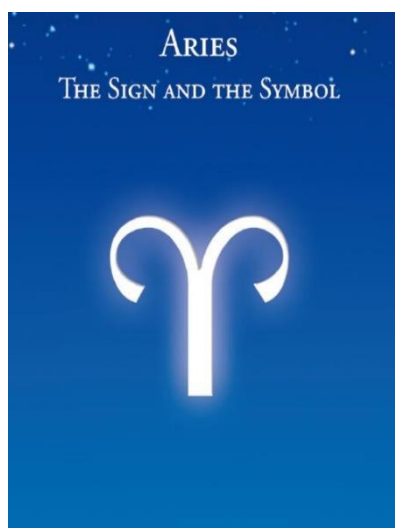
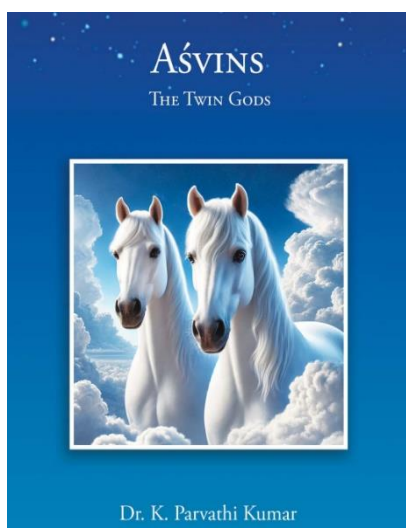
