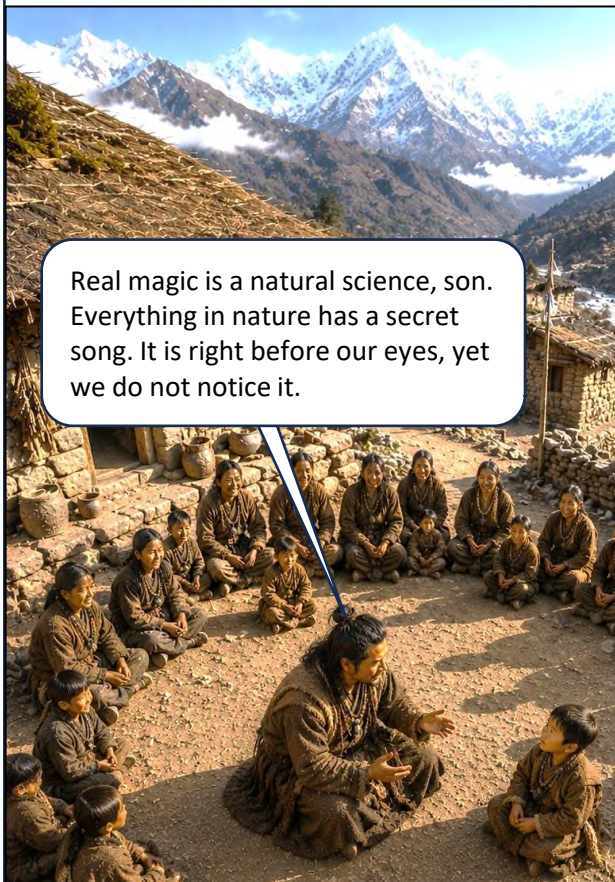
While other children spent their days playing games, this young boy was different. He would often sit quietly for hours, gazing at the stars.

The answer stirred something deep within the boy. He stared at the stars, listened to the wind, and looked in amazement, trying to understand the grand intelligence.



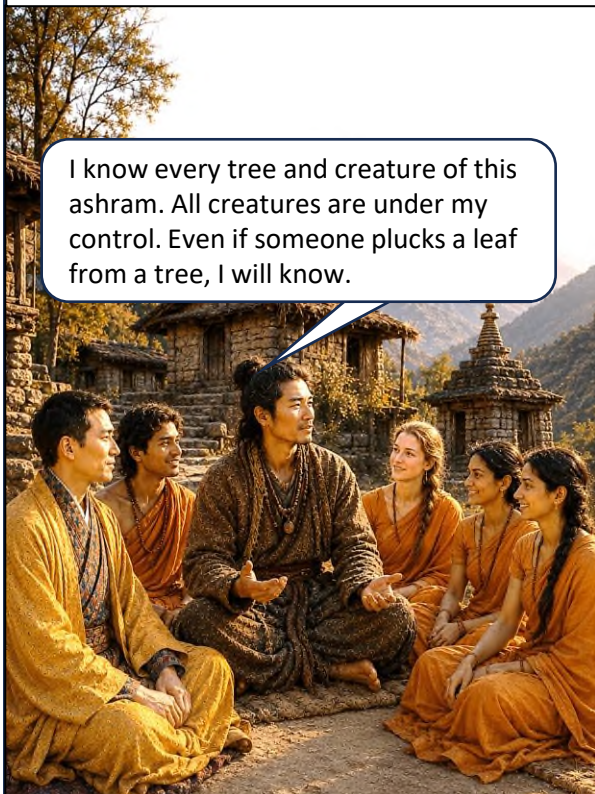
Determined to learn the science of magic, Lokayata traveled deep into India to find a great Master of Magic.



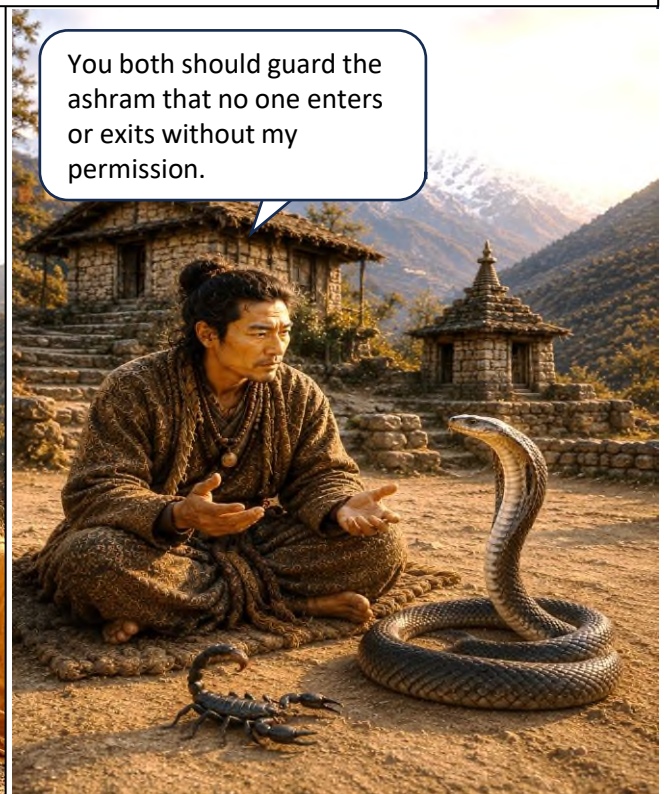

As a young magician, Lokayata was teaching and demonstrating magic in his ashram. Sitting at his place, he knew what was happening anywhere within the compound.

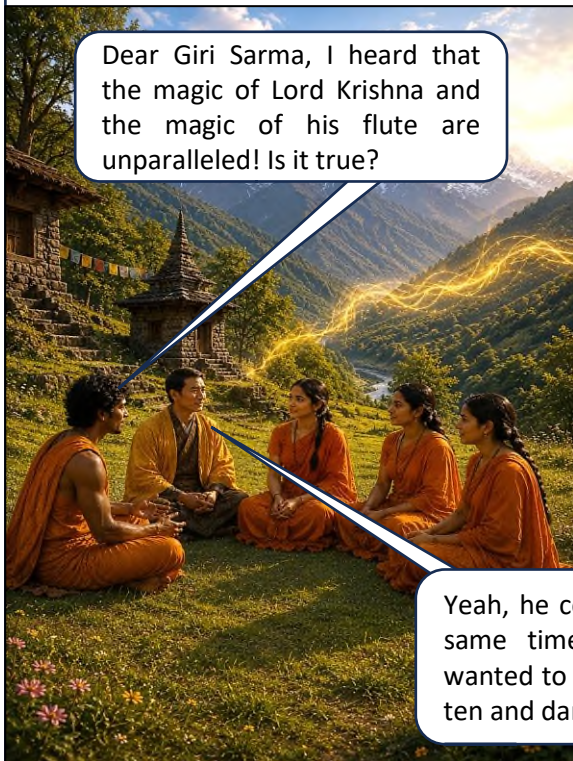


I know every tree and creature of this ashram. All creatures are under my control. Even if someone plucks a leaf from a tree, I will know.

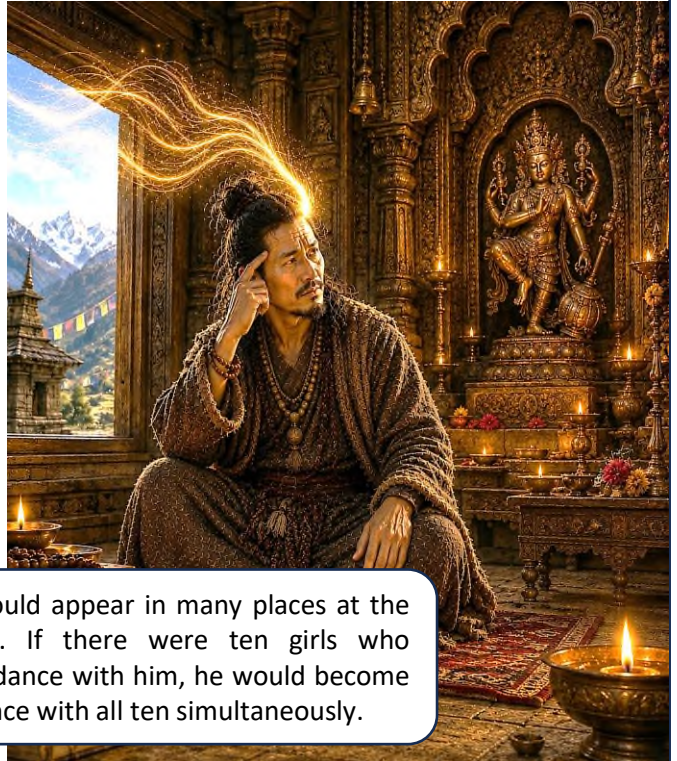


You both should guard the ashram that no one enters or exits without my permission.

Through clairaudience and telepathy, Lokayata could hear distant conversations and perceive unspoken thoughts, no matter how far away the students were.

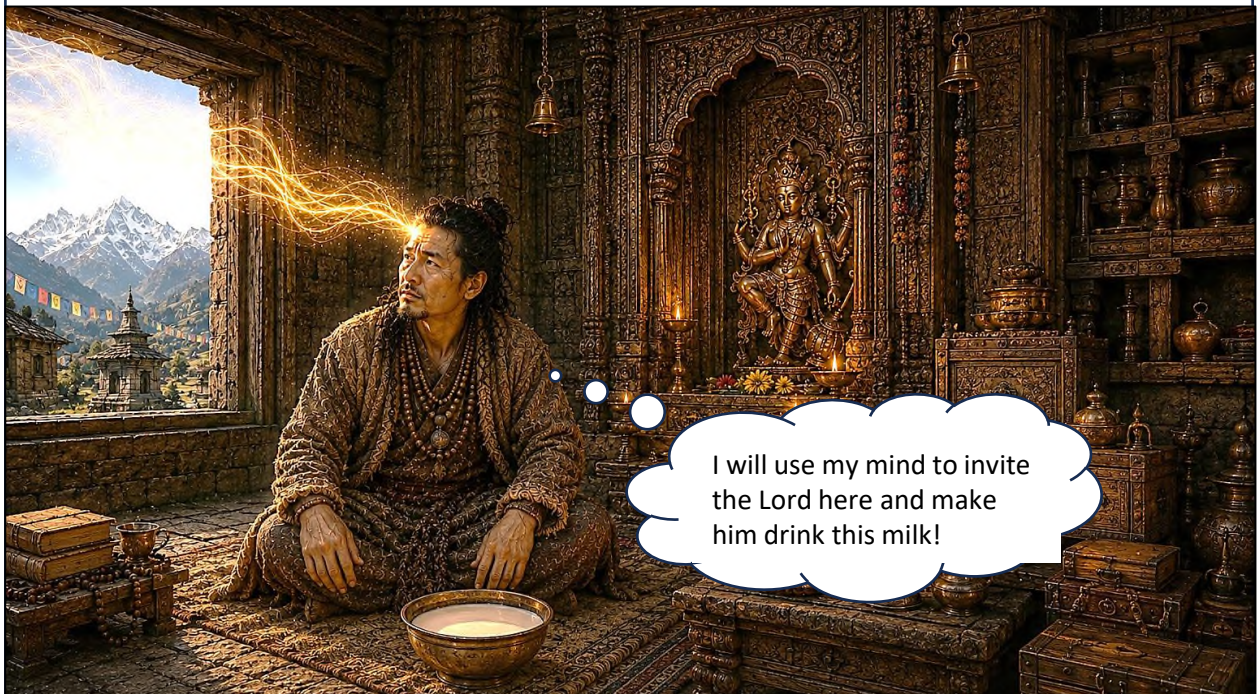


Dear Giri Sarma, I heard that the magic of Lord Krishna and the magic of his flute are unparalleled! Is it true?



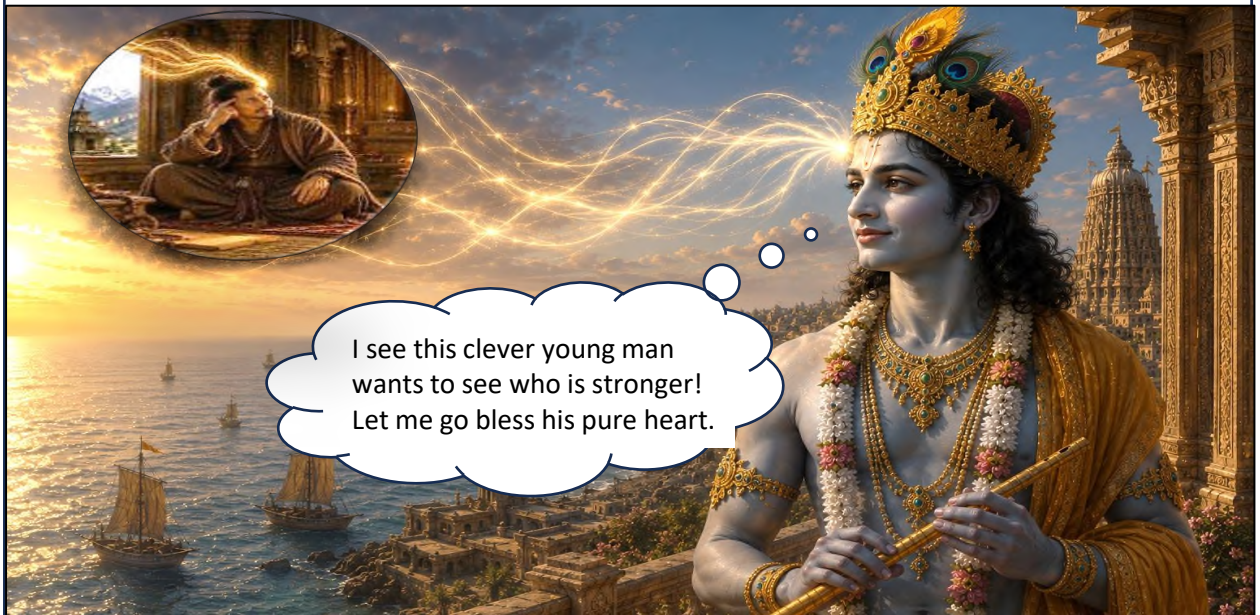
Yeah, he could appear in many places at the same time. If there were ten girls who wanted to dance with him, he would become ten and dance with all ten simultaneously.

As he opened his eyes, he found Krishna everywhere, smiling at him. Lokayata was deeply touched.

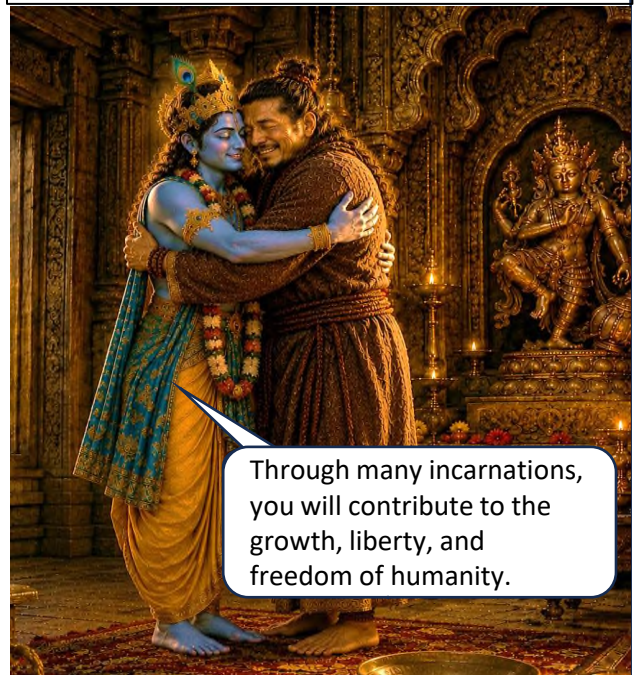


His inquisitive mind moved away from the black magic and was immersed in Krishna's white magic.

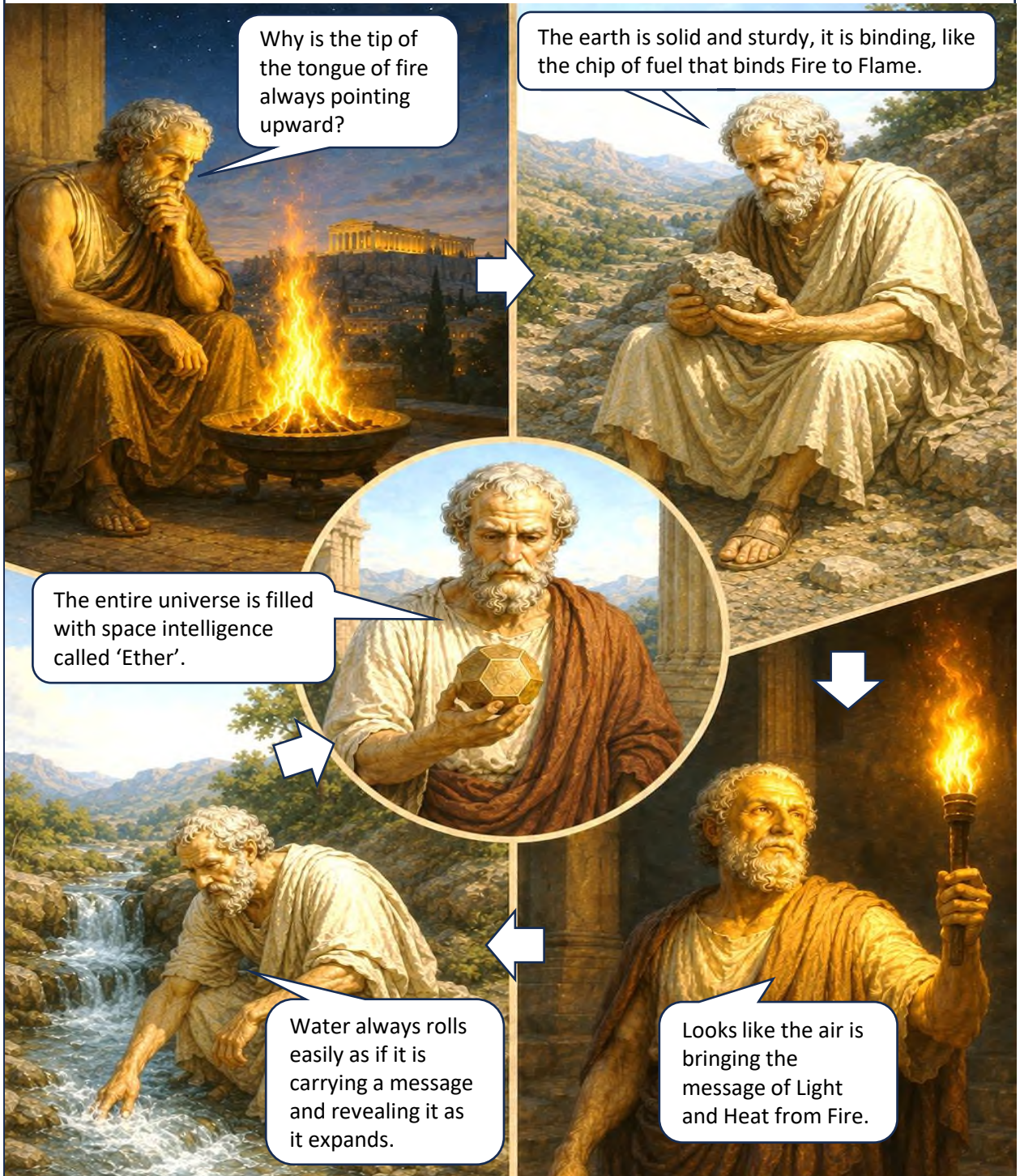

One may google with keyword "Platonic Solids" to learn more about them.

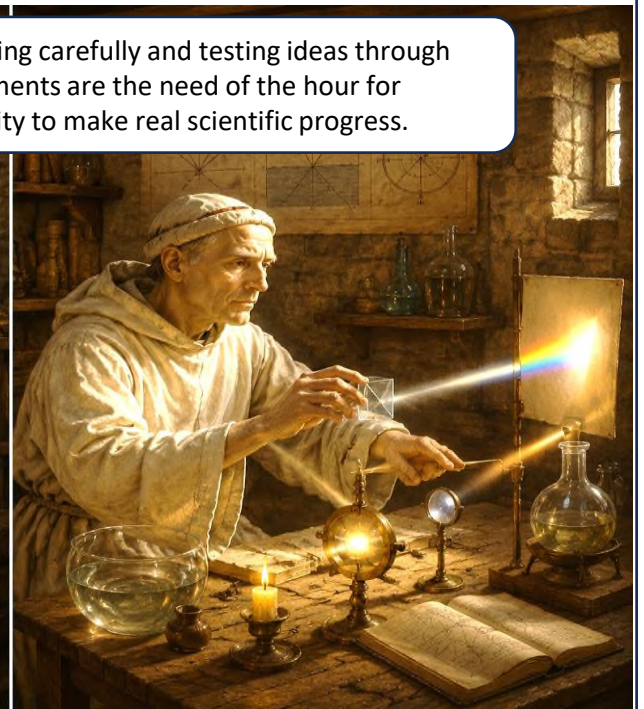

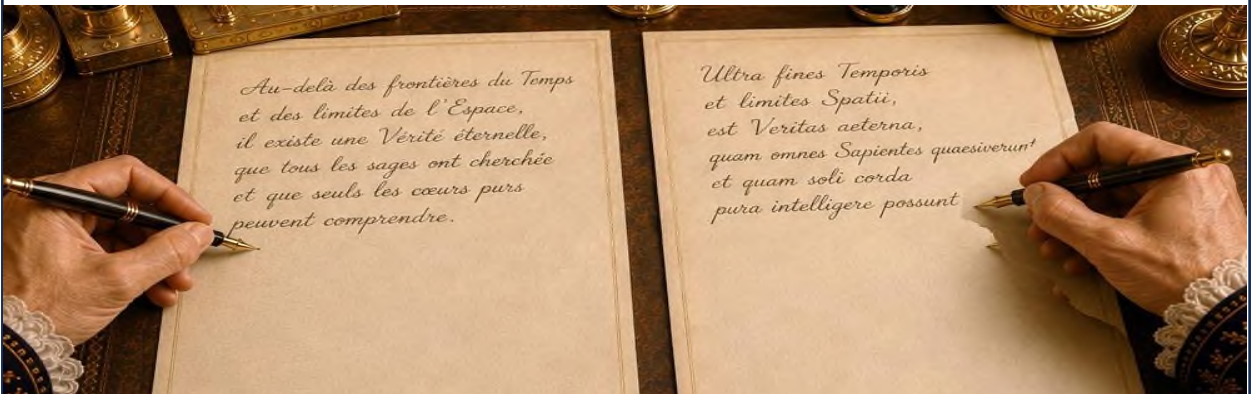


He not only said that it was he who had helped her in her childhood, but he also drew the exact same artwork, to her astonishment.

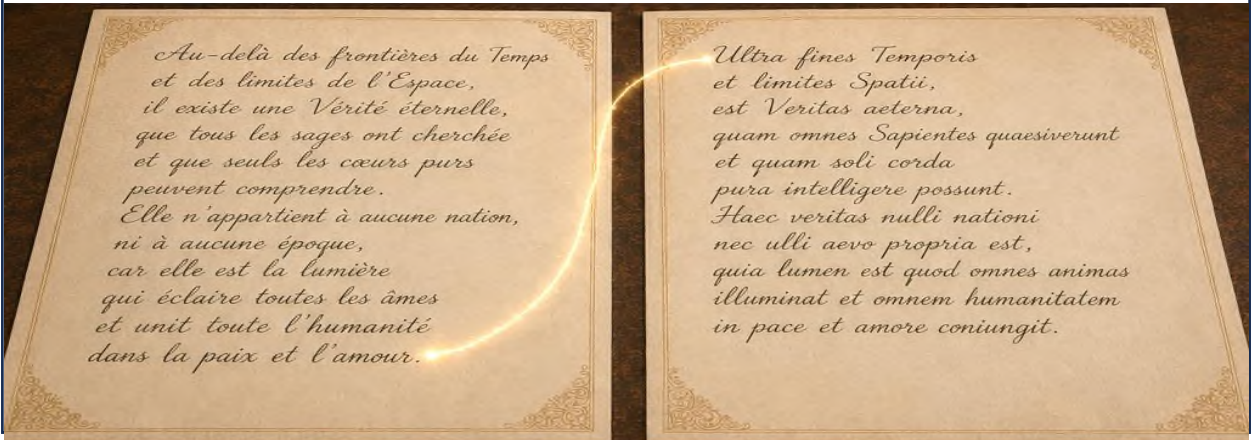
He was fluent in many languages like Sanskrit, Arabic, Hebrew, German, French, Italian and English. He was a Master of Music and Painting.

The Count and Prince Charles of Hesse-Kassel built an alchemical laboratory for esoteric experiments at the summer estate of Louisenlund.



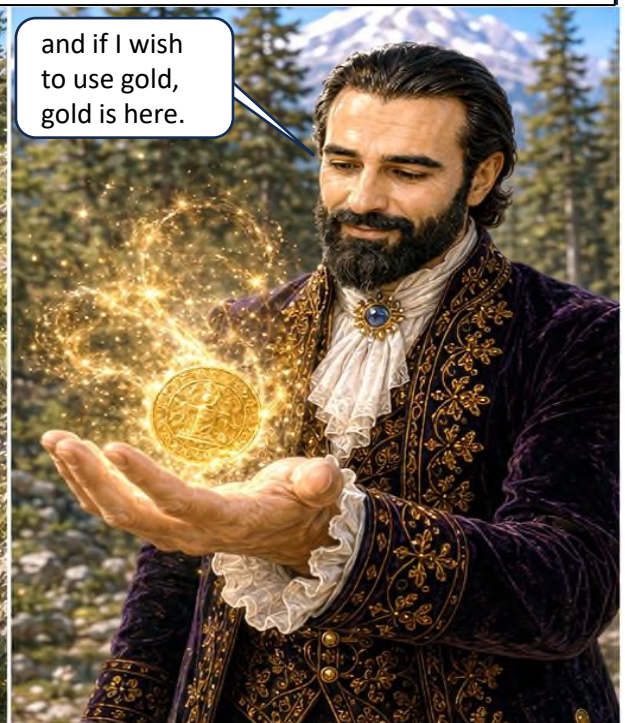

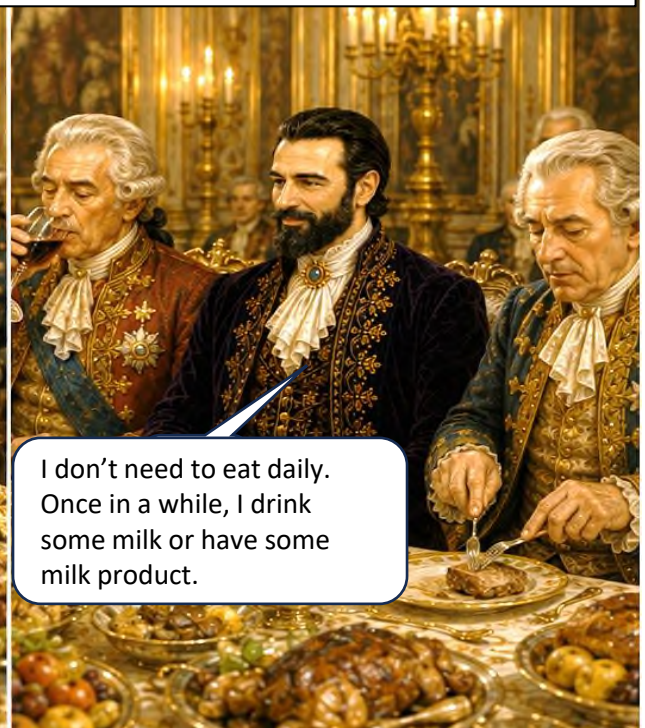
He could "melt" flaws out of diamonds and transform base metals. The Count possessed deep knowledge of chemistry and could alter the appearance of materials at will.



He demonstrated an absolute dominion of Love over universal atomic substance.

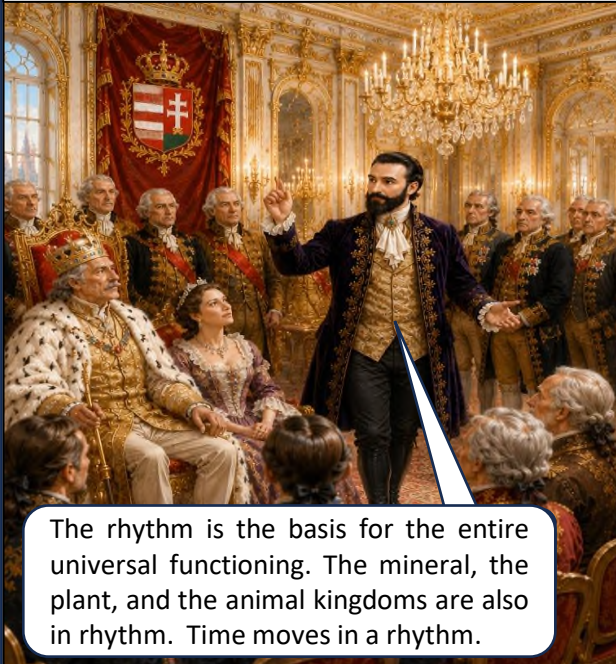

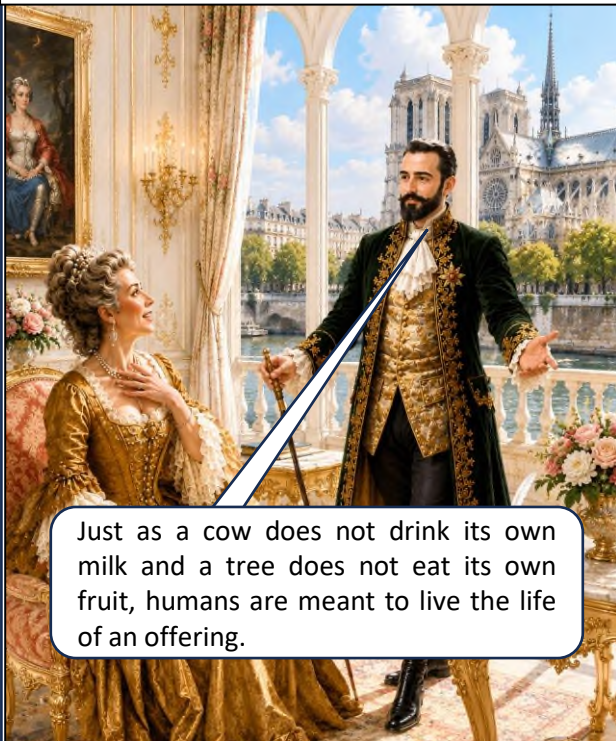
People were stunned to learn that he lived without eating daily yet remained ever energetic.

He emphasized that real happiness lies in living life as an offering.



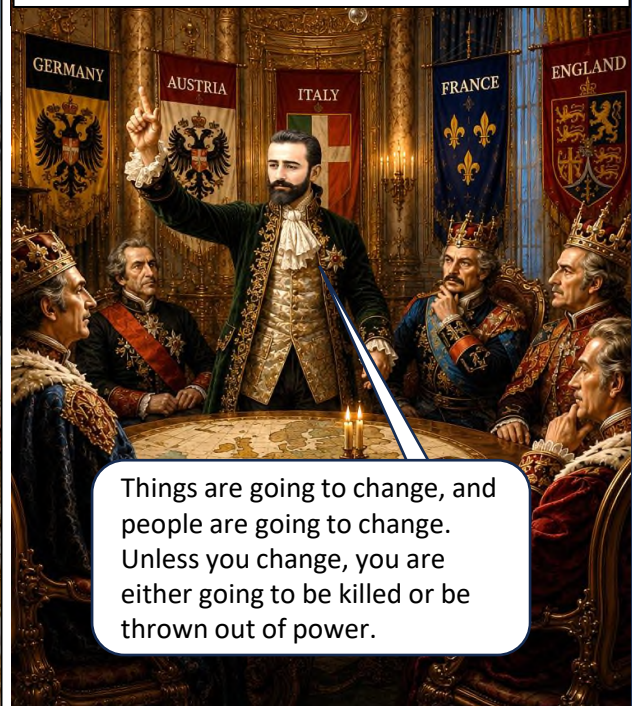
Just as a cow does not drink its own milk and a tree does not eat its own fruit, humans are meant to live the life of an offering.

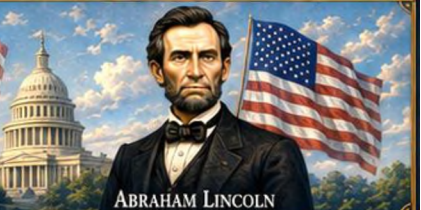

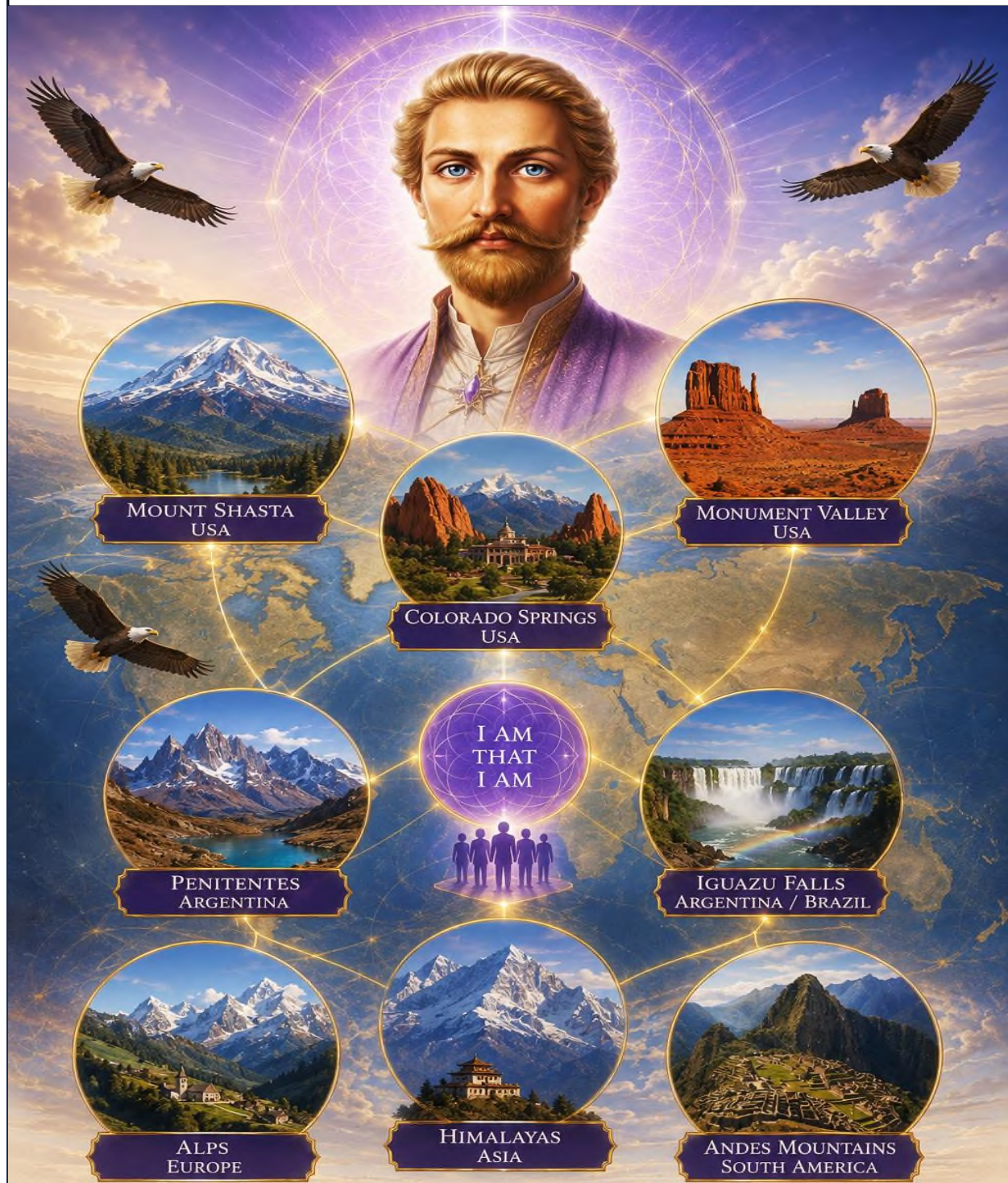

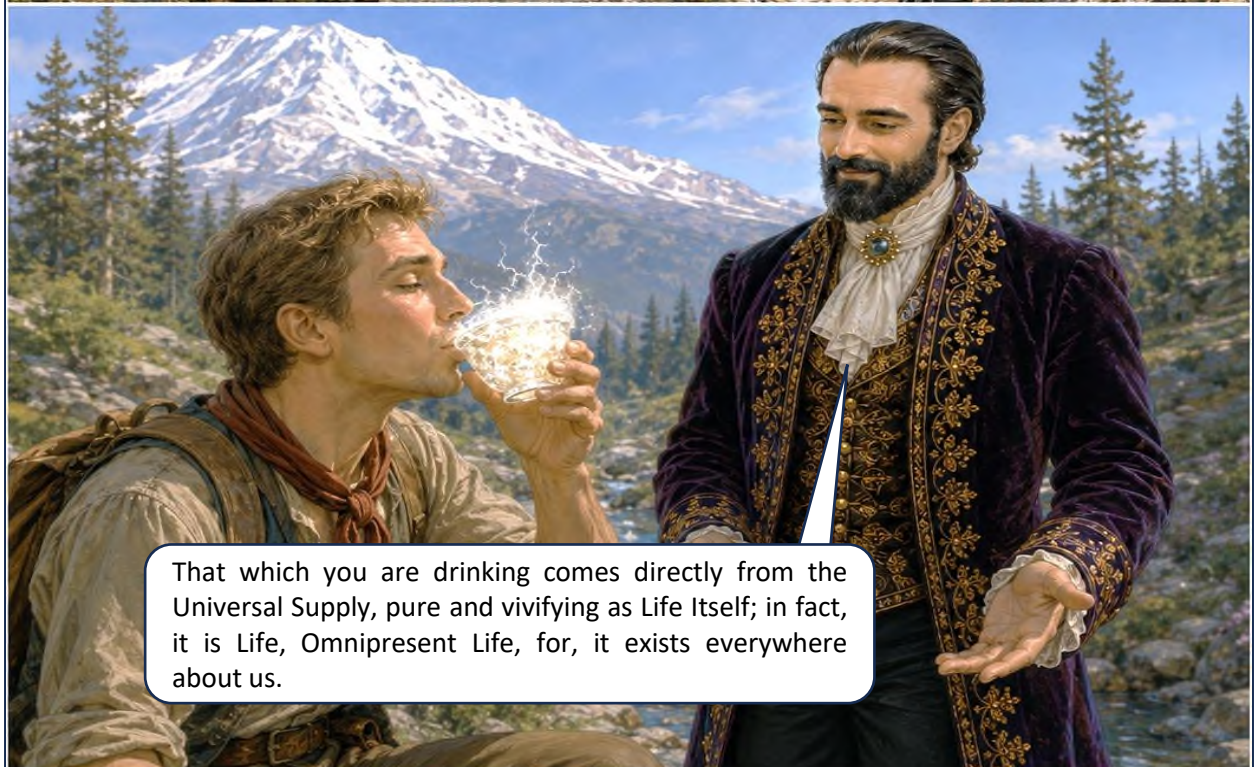

I am terrified, but I must realize that the Presence of God is everywhere, and one part of God cannot harm another.



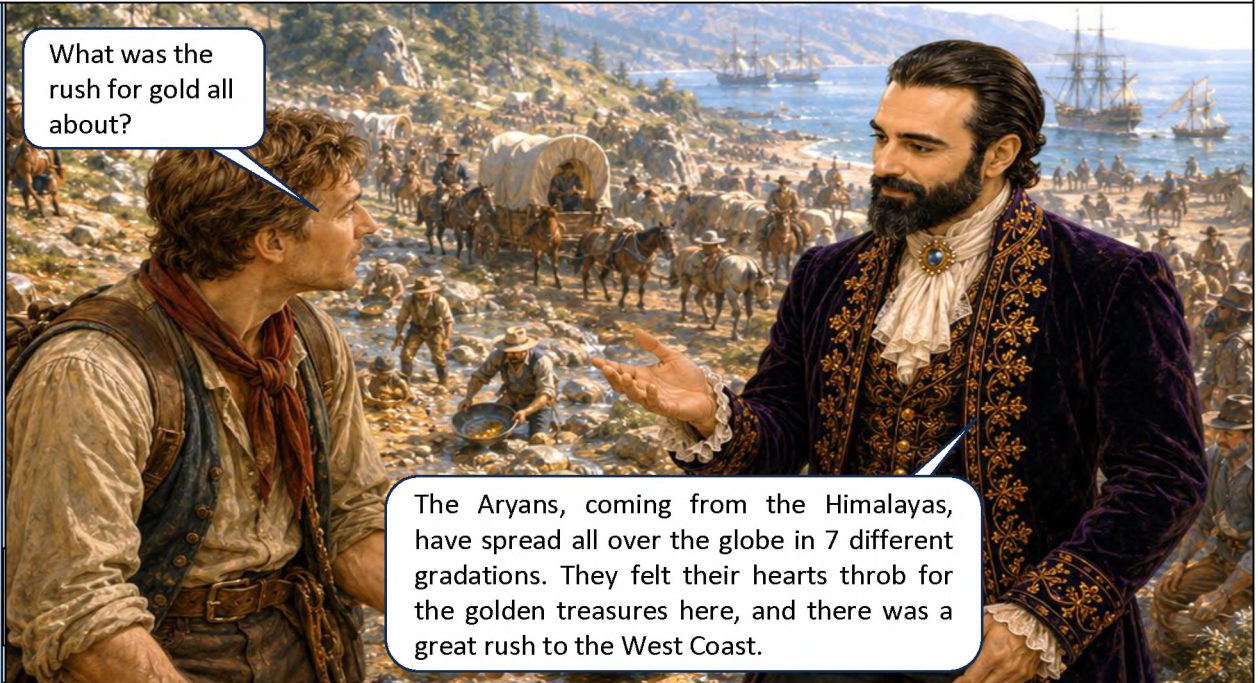
The big cat's fierce eyes soften, and it happily purrs and rubs against the hiker's leg like a gentle house cat.



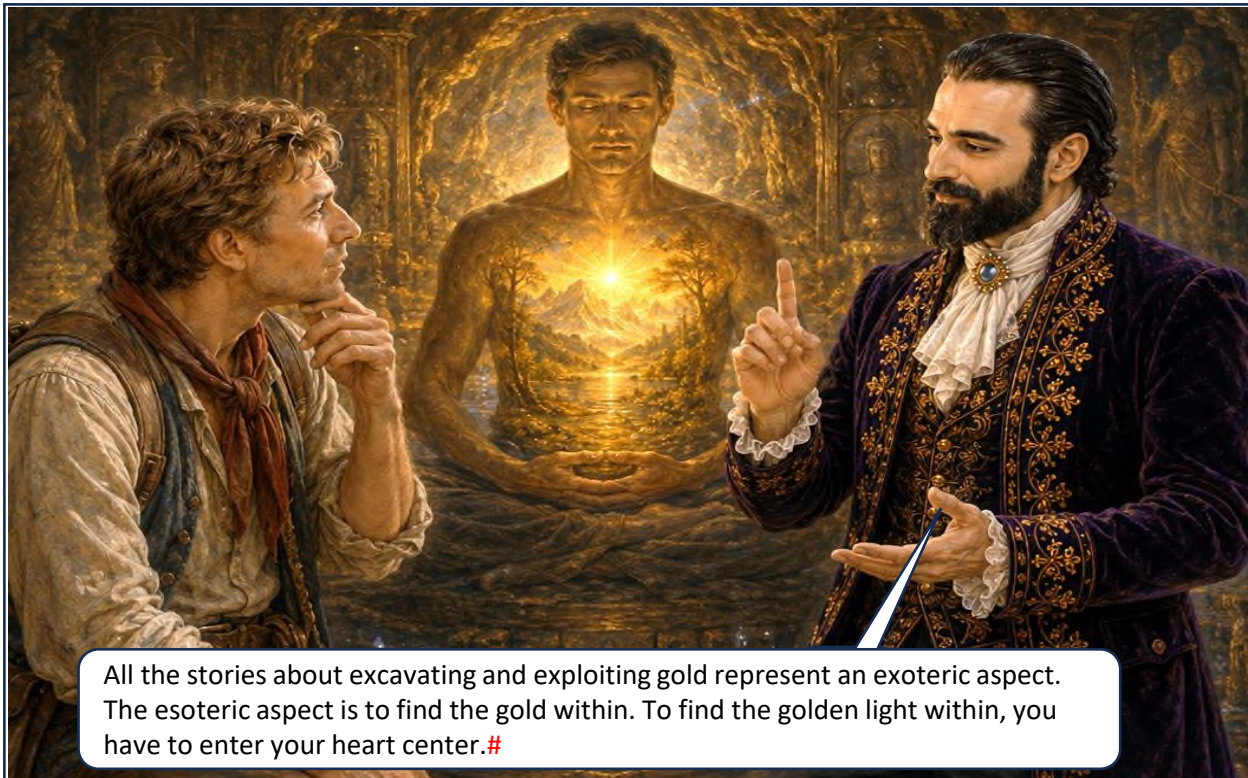
My Son, I saw the great strength within you. You have conquered fear. My congratulations!

What was the rush for gold all about?

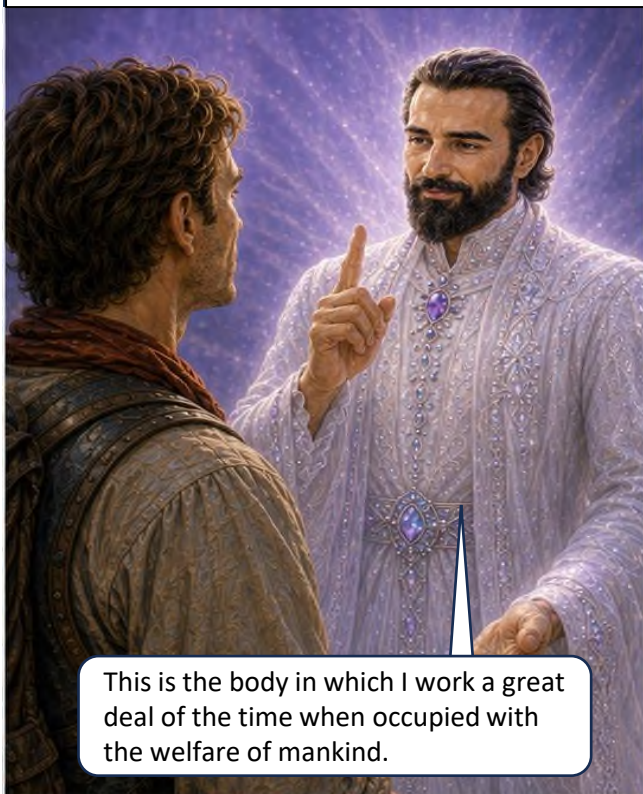

Heart center is your body's feel-good energy spot, located right in the middle of your chest. It helps you feel love, kindness, and peace.

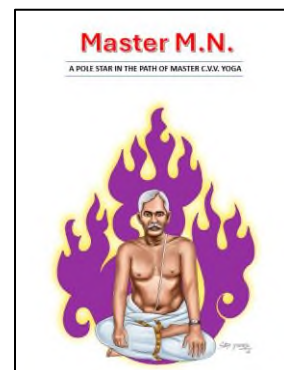
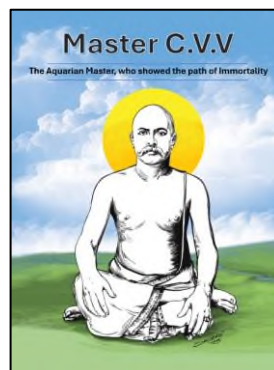
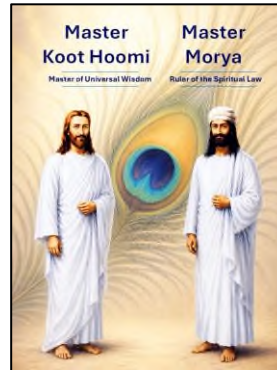
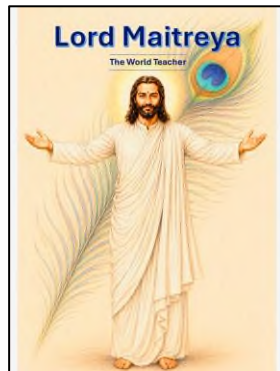
Master C.S.G.
