



Whenever darkness threatens to overpower the lamp of wisdom, divinity comes down and manifests as a Master. Such Masters visit our planet every now and serve humanity as a harmonious instrument of divinity. Here is the story of a Master, Master C.V.V., who led such a full life where every aspect of it was a significant demonstration of divine wisdom.

Master C.V.V. was born on 4th August 1868 at Kumbakonam, in the famous temple town of Tamil Nadu State, South India. His parents were Sri Kuppuswamy lyyengar and Smt. Kamamma. On the eleventh day of his birth the child was named as Venkata Rao Venka Swamy Rao.



Like Gautama the Buddha, he was initiated through the sacred ritual of upanayana at the age of five though it is normally performed at the age of seven.



After the initiation, he was given in adoption to his paternal aunt Kanchupati Subbamma. The elementary education of the boy took place in Kumbakonam and the higher education in the town of Srirangam.



By the 18th year, he was proficient in the Vedas – both in chanting as well as applying them in daily life. He was fluent in Sanskrit, Telugu, Tamil, and English languages.



At this age, he came across theosophical literature. In fact, he remained a member of the Theosophical Society # till the end.

* Theosophical Society, head quartered in Madras, India is an organization that emphasized universal brotherhood and understanding of Wisdom from across globe.

He was married to Smt. Rukmini when he was twelve years old and through her, he had three sons and three daughters. She passed away when he was thirty-six years old.



In his thirty-eighth year, he married Smt. Venkamma and through her, he had three sons and one daughter. Venkamma's entry into his life was another significant milestone in occultism. She served him as the medium for eliciting cosmic information, which he used for conducting his scientific and spiritual experiments.





At the financial front, he tried his hand in many a business venture. He bequeathed much property in his town. He sold them one by one, to feed the people who loved to gather in his house every day. In his house, starting with breakfast, there was sumptuous lunch with 12 to 16 items and dinner for many —a daily festivity indeed.



He was a musician of a high order. When he sang on the banks of river Kaveri, many beings flocked around him, totally absorbed in music.



Master was a very popular person in the town. He served as the mayor of the town. Many elite were attracted to him, though they did not know why.

A miraculous event happened in his 42nd year. It was in 1910 on 31st March at midnight. At that time, Halley's comet touched our solar system.








When they opened the door, they saw him sitting in veerasana posture, absorbed in meditation and surrounded by a brilliant light. They did not dare to disturb him and inquire.




They returned to their homes and the next morning; they drew courage and approached him once again. They asked him what happened the last night.


He even conducted communications with planetary intelligences, made certain arrangements with them.




He experimented with cosmic sounds and formulated certain sound formulae to effectively rectify the human psyche.



As promised, he came out of his experiments and called out to people.









Karma is a sequential action. Every action will have its consequence, and it is believed that the birth of every human is governed by his actions in past life.








Soon after the first prayer, he opened the question & answers session, as he knew there were many questions on everyone's mind.










































Everyone present there were enthralled that Master was giving out the ancientmost wisdom of yoga in the most suitable manner for the modern age.





As the days passed by, the word spread and people from distant places started getting touched by Master's yoga. The Yoga Friends School, true to its name, became a hub for transformation.








Master C.V.V. also used to have correspondence with all mediums that seek guidance and used to give instructions on special courses, prayers and adjustments.




He conducted yoga congregations during December 29th, May 29th, equinoxes, Solstices etc.




With such a golden body, one would transcend limitations like disease and death, and he had demonstrated that by leaving the body and returning to it after a few days.








Master C.V.V. left his physical sheath on 12th May 1922 but continues to give his presence to all those who submit themselves to the path.



He promised that whoever follows yoga for 12 years shall attain the etheric body. The lives of Sri Potharaju Narsimham, Master M.N., Master V.P.S, Master E.K., Sri Kotta Rama Kotaiah Garu, Master K.P.K. and many others stand as shining examples of this promise being fulfilled. Many truth seekers have followed these mediums, spreading the path of Master C.V.V. yoga.




Amongst those followers of C.V.V. Yoga, Mynampati Narasimham (Master M.N.) stands as a Pole Star, who had dedicated his life for the spread of Yoga, initiating and guiding many disciples.

Narasimham had a personal calamity that he lost both parents, parent-in-law and a younger brother in a short span of about 3 years of time. That left a sense of void in him, leading him to depression.



Narasimham was an advocate practicing in Ongole and is a nephew of Tanguturi Prakasam, who is known as Andhra Kesari.




In the 1919, Narasimham visited his maternal uncle Dr. Janakiram, who was staying in Madras and shared the agony and distress that he was suffering from.




Dr. Janakiram, explained that Master C.V.V. has an ability to scan through the past lives of beings, rectify their limitations and set the beings on the path of progress.




Dr. Janakiram and Narasimham reached Kumbakonam. As they reached Master C.V.V.'s yoga school, they found the Master at the threshold of the Yoga School Friends Society, as if waiting for someone. As the Master already knew Dr. Janakiram, he welcomed him with a smile. He looked at Narasimham and smilingly asked:




so much of peace and joy in the heart.
He was initiated into Master Yoga and
was given the medium number 666.



Soon, Narasimham started leading prayers and many disciples who joined him in prayers got miraculous cures for long due illnesses. He followed the yoga of Master with much commitment, while he was initiated in 1919, even by 1921, Master C.V.V. visualized in M.N. the future Master, and therefore called him the Little Master.



On 21st March 1927, Master M.N. established Satya Yoga School in his own house as a branch of the Yoga School at Kumbakonam and relentless worked in the direction of "Prana Treat and Yoga Teach," initiating around 1200 persons in his lifetime and curing innumerable diseases through Prayer.



Master C.V.V. prophesied that his energy will travel all over the globe starting from Europe to South America to North America and then back to India via Australia. While the energy chose Master E.K. to be the medium to cross the oceans and continents, it is Master M.N.'s invisible hand that guides the groups in the East and in the West.

Master C.V.V. said that he would initiate 1000 mediums and even demonstrated in the case of Dr. Ekkirala Krishnamacharya, who is fondly called as Master E.K., that being in physical form is not mandatory for him to initiate a disciple.



Master E.K. had a deep bond with the Gayatri Mantra, right from his 7th year. Goddess Gayatri, who is often referred as Veda Mata, is his friend, teacher and guide.






During his graduation days, he used to go to Shanti Ashram and sit under a Ficus Religiosa tree from Friday evening till Monday morning chanting Gayatri. After marriage, Master E.K. set up a new house in Guntur and had a picture of Goddess Gayatri in his shrine room and started meditating. After a month or so, when he closed his eyes, he started seeing a different picture; he was seeing the lower part of a person.



The upper portion was gradually revealed, the face could be seen clearly. The picture of Master C.V.V. has magnetic, majestic, peaceful and blissful appearance.




Throughout the meditation, the same vision remained stable. Day by day, the vision became clearer. After a few days, the image began to reveal more details: the lower half appeared as a strong and sturdy person, while the upper half resembled Gayatri Mata.




Krishnamacharya could not recollect who this new person was, but it looked the man who made way into his meditation settled down comfortably in his heart.






MASTER C.V.V.
