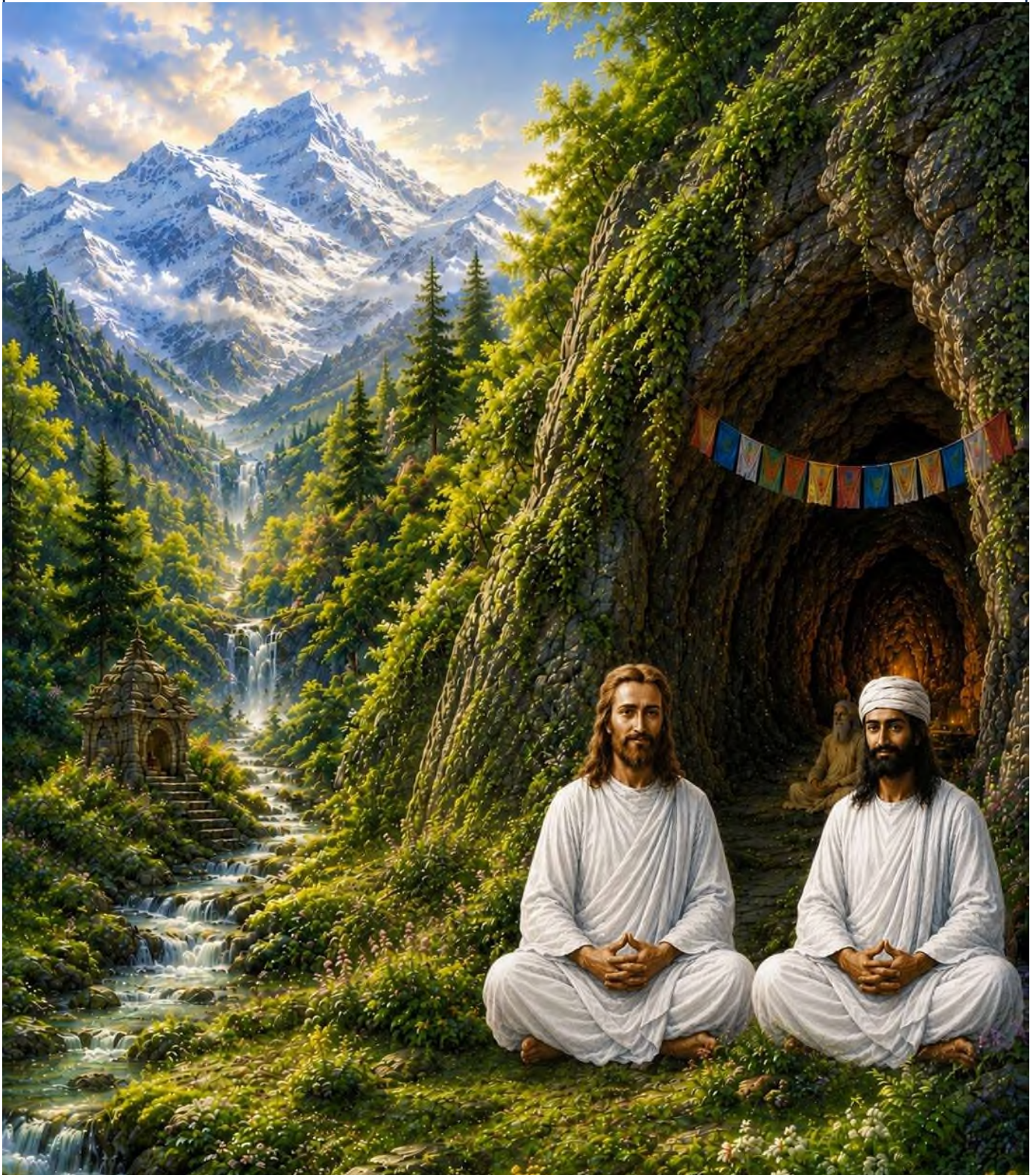


Numerous Kumaras and Rishis descended to Earth for the upliftment of humanity.



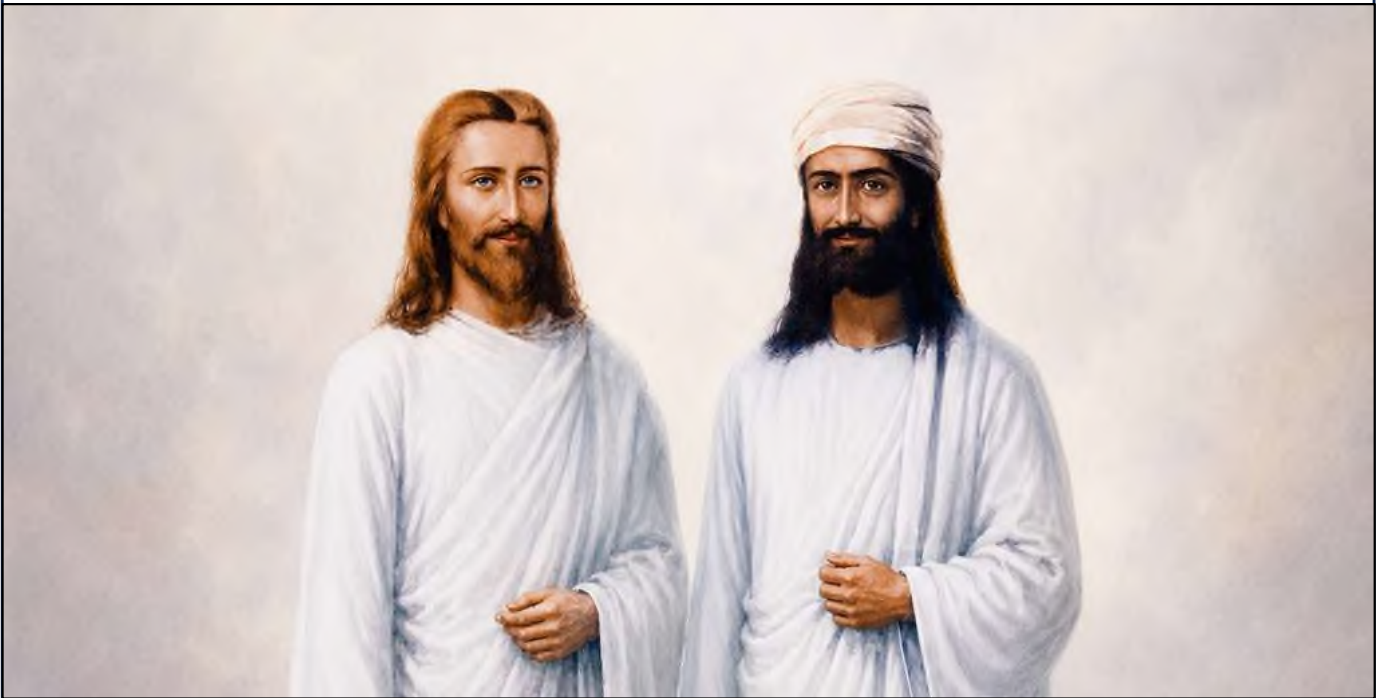
Yugas, Manvantaras, and Kalpas are all cycles of time.

Far in the sacred Himalayas existed hidden regions inhabited by great Rishis and Yogis. Among them was the cave of Kalāpa, where Maharshis carried on their spiritual work far away from ordinary public life. There lived two great Maharshis, Maru and Devapi #, who worked silently for the preservation of Dharma through many Yugas.



In the twenty-first century Maru is called Morya and Devapi is called Koot Hoomi.

Very few people knew who they truly were. The great Puranas mentioned them only briefly, as though even the scriptures wished to protect their secrecy. The Vishnu Purana spoke of them. The Bhagavata Purana hinted at them. The Kalki Purana revealed a little more. But nowhere was their entire story fully told. For the Maharshis themselves preferred silence.



Many seekers of truth were silently guided by these Masters from behind the veil. Even in recent centuries, Madame Helena P. Blavatsky, Alice A. Bailey, Nicholas Roerich, David Anrias, and Master E.K. came in contact with these Himalayan Masters and offered rare glimpses into their work, wisdom, and personality through their writings and communications.



Maru belonged to the Solar Dynasty — the sacred lineage into which Lord Rama himself was born. He was the son of Seeghra Varma who reigned from the ancient Kosala kingdom with Ayodhya as his capital.



The royal priest taught Maru the sciences of Yoga, Dharma, consciousness, Karma, rebirth, and the subtle laws governing life and creation along with Vedas.



Right from his childhood, Maru was more inclined towards the path of Yoga and Dharma.



Recognizing his inclination, the king sends Maru to the hermitage of Sage Parasara for further education.

Far away, in the Lunar Dynasty, another extraordinary child was growing up. His name was Devapi. He was the eldest son of King Prateepa. Prateepa had three sons: Devapi, Santanu, and Bahlika.



Like Maru, Devapi was inclined toward the occult sciences from childhood, and hence he was sent to the hermitage of Sage Parasara.



In the hermitage, Devapi met Maitreya, son of Divodasa, Maru, and Vyasa, son of Sage Parasara. The four of them instantly developed a deep bond, as if they had known each other through many births.

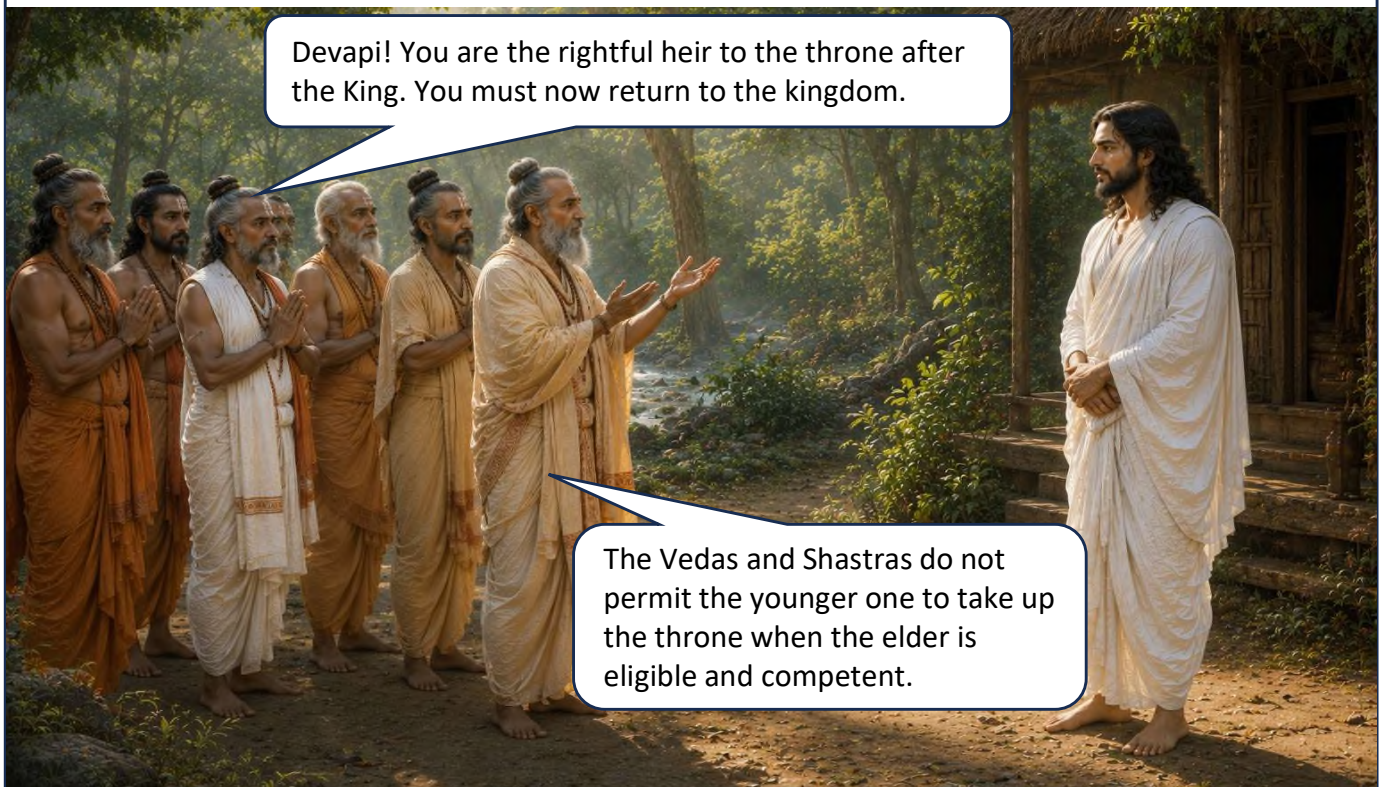


For over 50 years, they studied the Vishnu Purana. They also attained higher yogic states through which they could function in the physical, subtle, and causal planes of existence #.



#. The **physical** is everything we can see and touch, like our body, trees etc.. The **subtle** is made of our thoughts, feelings, and ideas that we cannot see but can experience. The **causal** is like a tiny hidden seed where all ideas and creations begin before they appear.

During this time, King Prateepa passed away. The royal priests and the Brahmins approach Devapi.



Maitreya, Maru, and Devapi all shared one thing in common: they were not inclined toward worldly possessions or marriage. Renouncing worldly rulership, they chose to walk the path of Yoga, guided by a divine calling. Santanu, the younger brother of Devapi, however, was inclined toward marriage, kingdom, and rulership.



Devapi asked what makes one ineligible, and they replied that a person must either be handicapped or be boycotted for following an anti-Vedic and irreligious path.

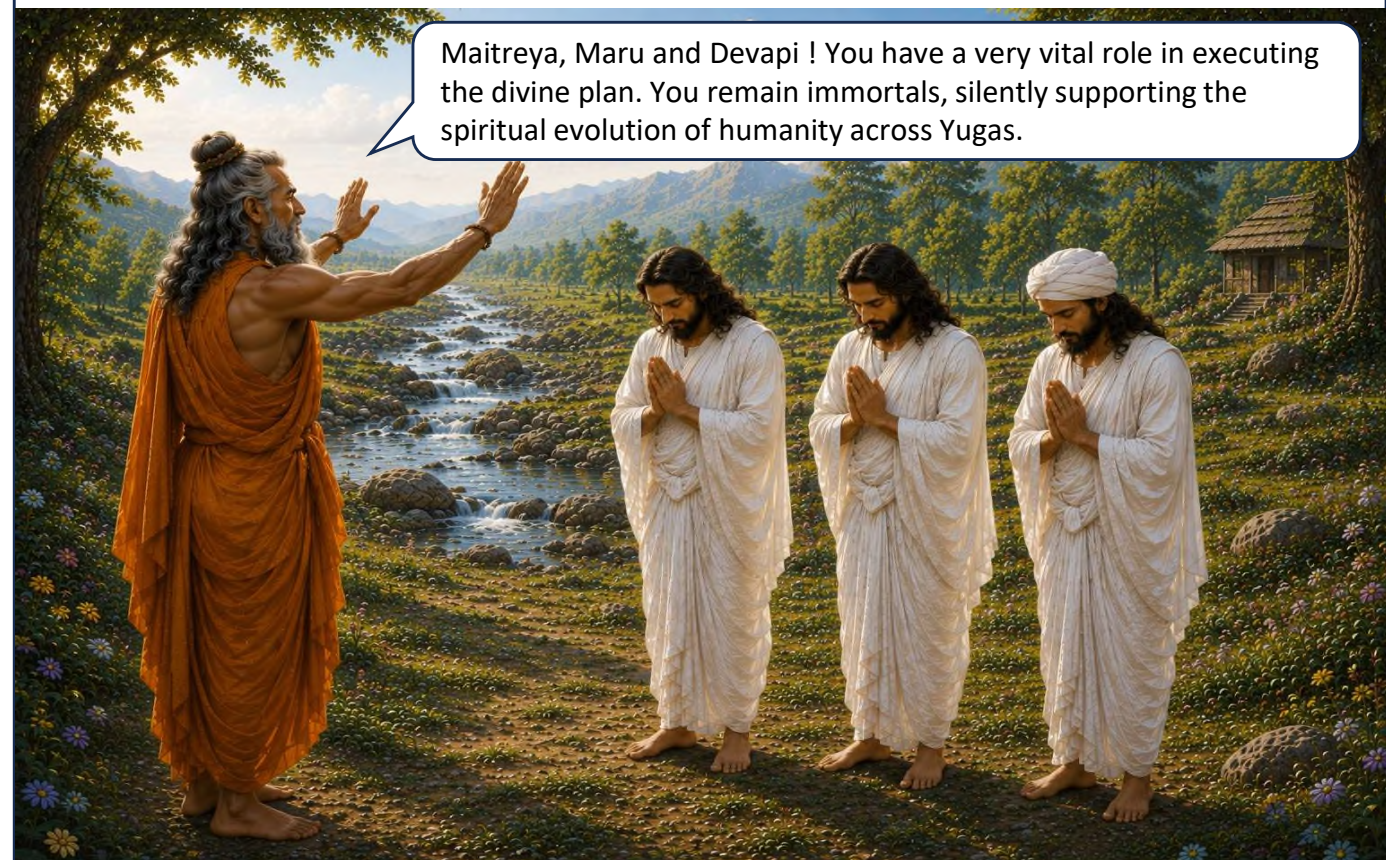


That is how Devapi quietly renounced the throne that rightfully belonged to him, and Santanu became the King of the Kuru Dynasty. Santanu later married Ganga with whom he would have a son of great valor who went on to become Bhishma.

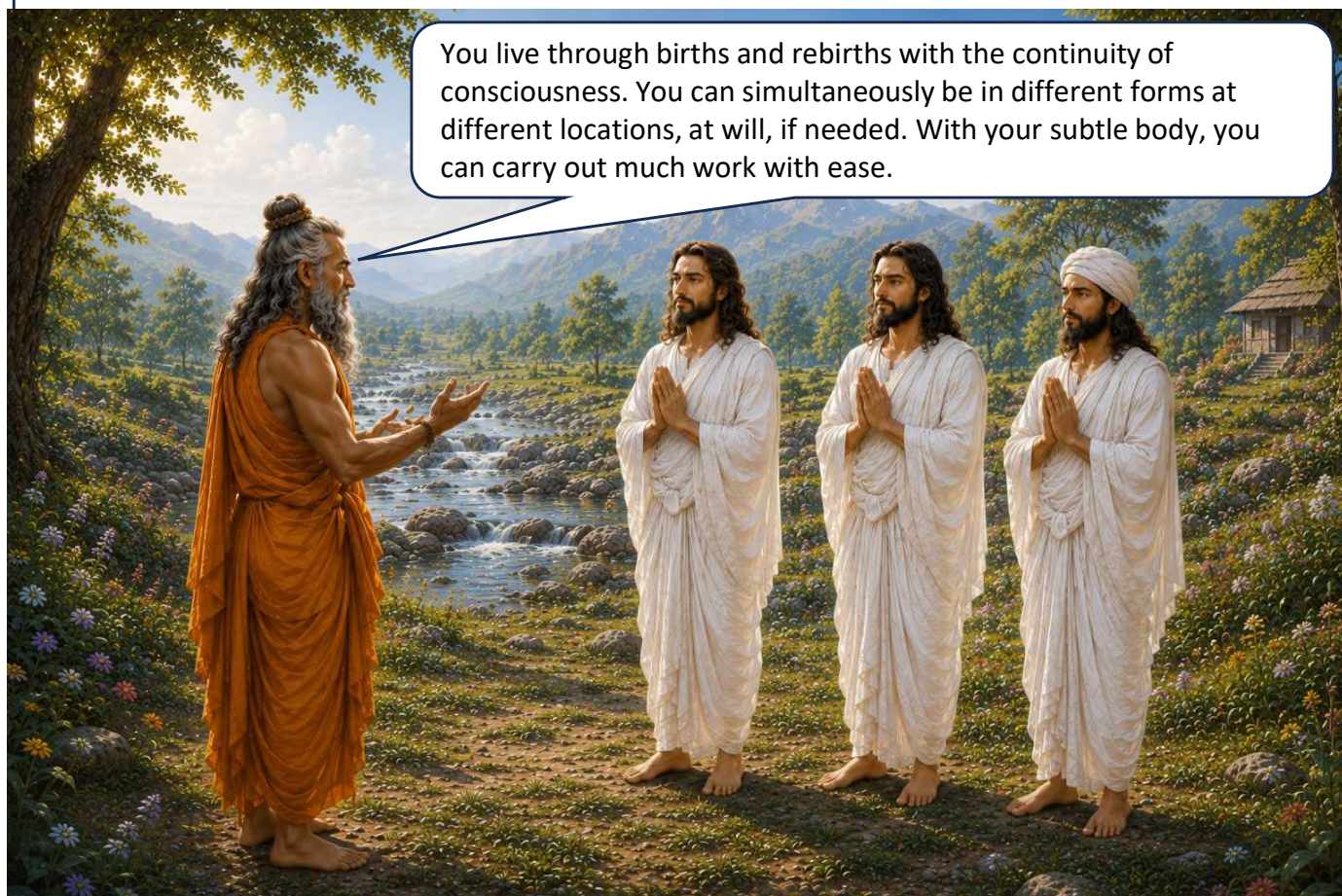


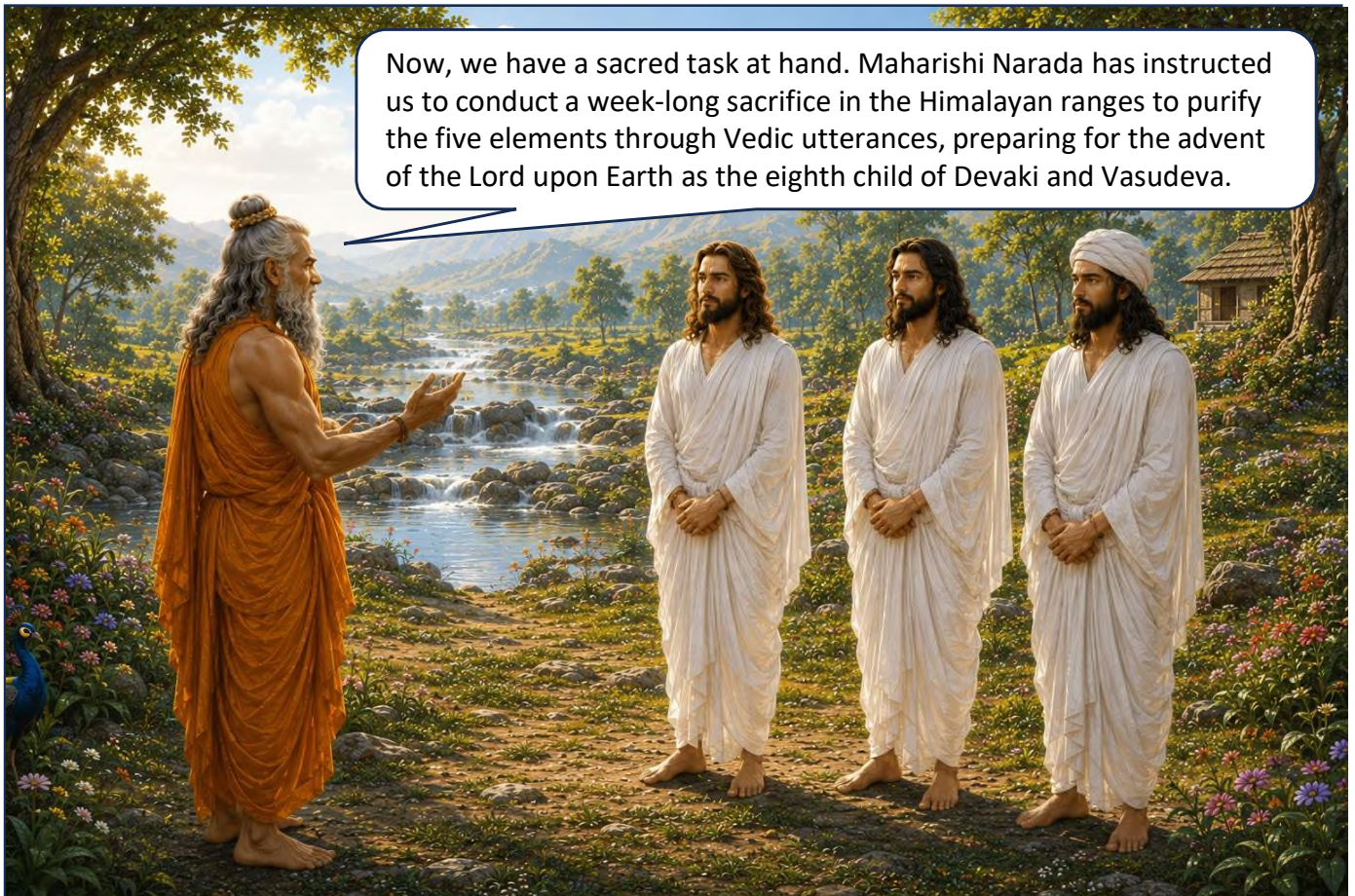
Here in the ashram, as the students finished their education, Parasara said:

Maitreya, Maru and Devapi ! You have a very vital role in executing the divine plan. You remain immortals, silently supporting the spiritual evolution of humanity across Yugas.



You live through births and rebirths with the continuity of consciousness. You can simultaneously be in different forms at different locations, at will, if needed. With your subtle body, you can carry out much work with ease.





Now, we have a sacred task at hand. Maharishi Narada has instructed us to conduct a week-long sacrifice in the Himalayan ranges to purify the five elements through Vedic utterances, preparing for the advent of the Lord upon Earth as the eighth child of Devaki and Vasudeva.

As guided by Sage Narada, seven seers conducted the sacrifice for a week that concluded on the day of Cancer full moon.



The Vedic utterances as we do now are never before (apoorva). They constitute the ethereal classical musical tones and reverberate in Akasha.

They travel forth from here unto the fetus in the womb of Devaki and be born.

Before the coming down of the World Teacher as Krishna there was a group-descent of Devas and Rishis who paved the way for the Lord. All of them were born as human beings in the surrounding villages.

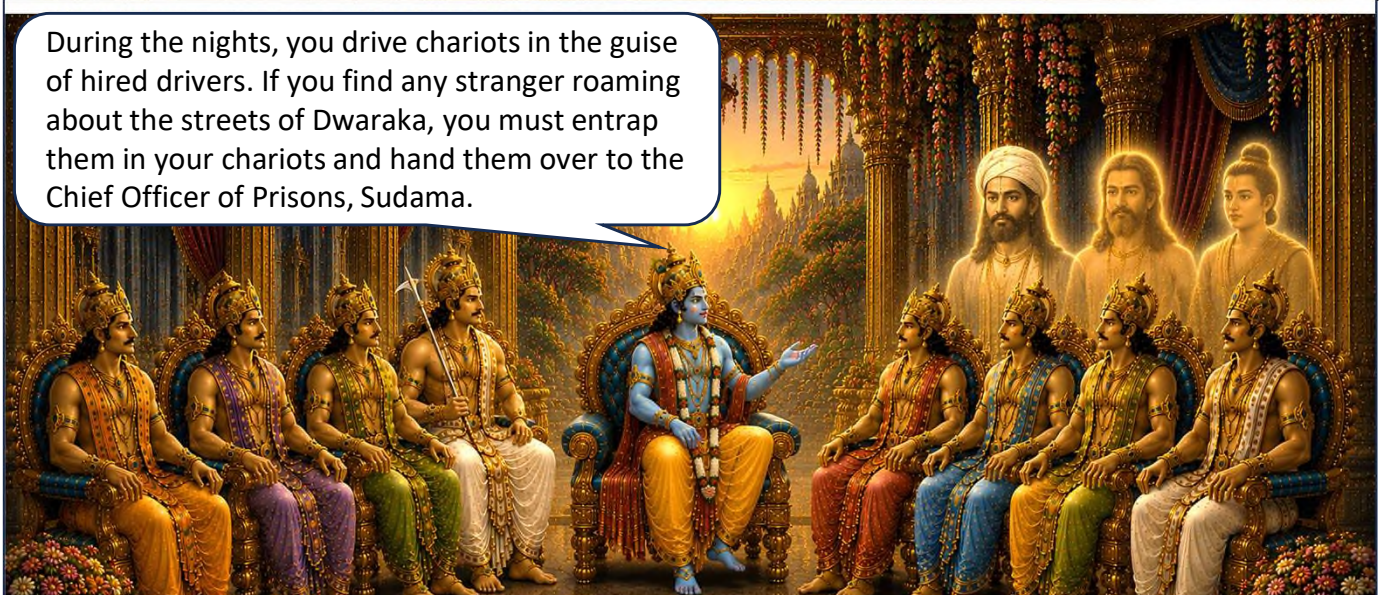
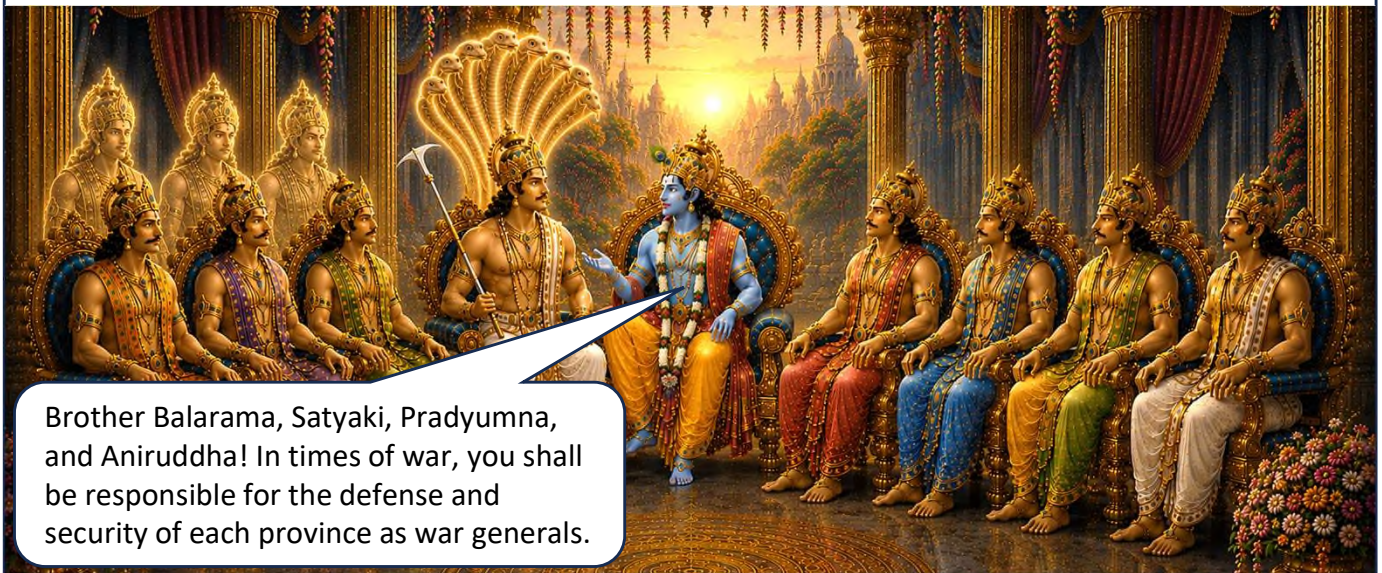
Among the Rishis, Maru was born as Madhuvrata. Devapi was born as Satanika and Sanatsujata was born as Satagopa.



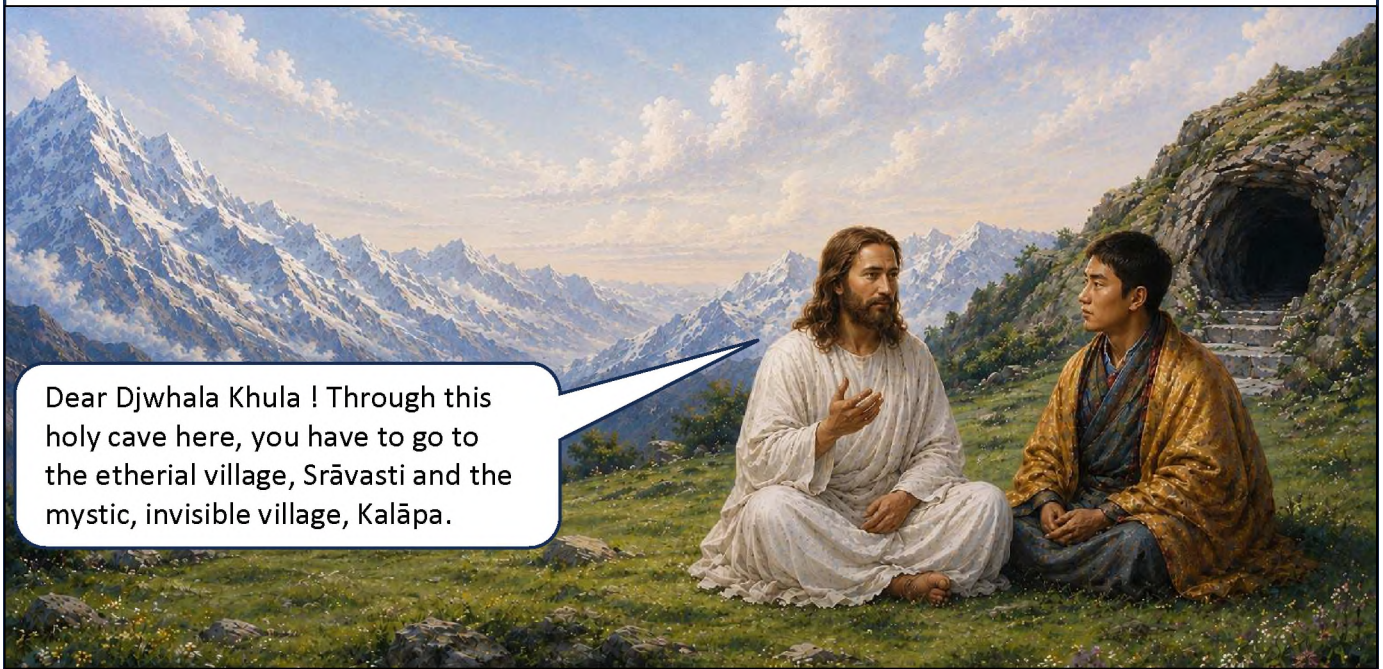

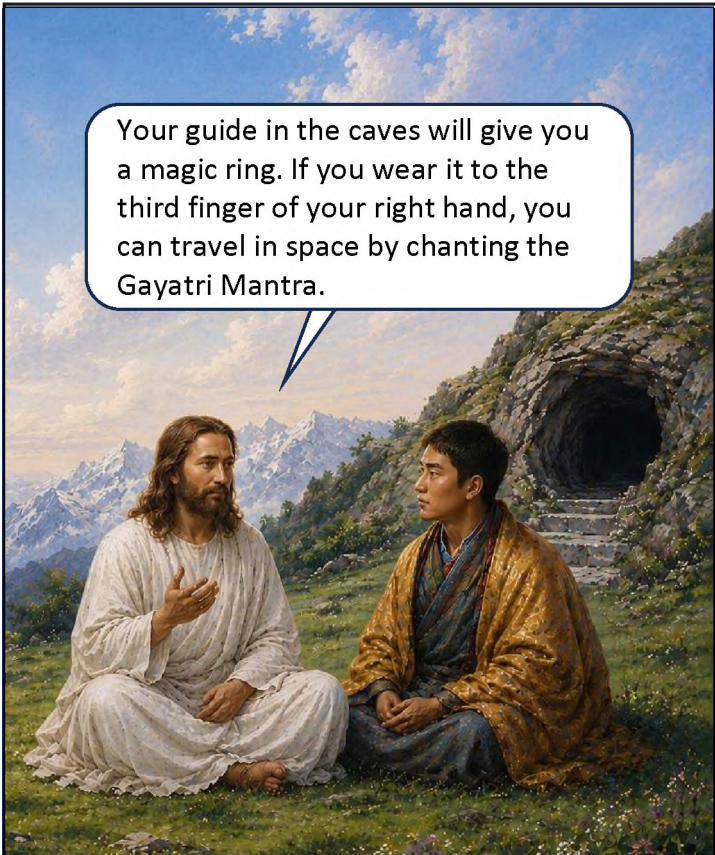

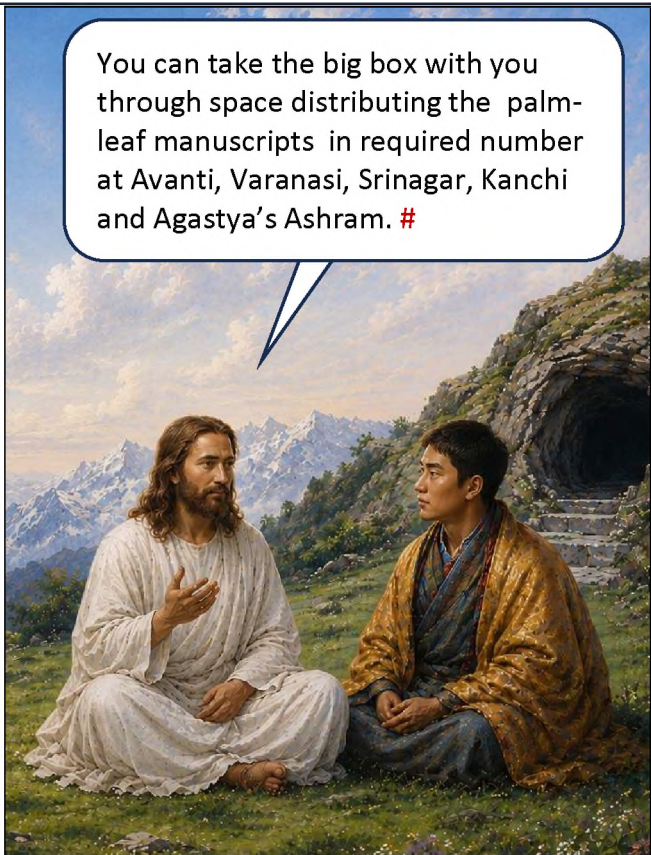

In the In the twenty-first century Djwhala Khula is known as Djwhal Khul, Master DK and the Tibetan.



Your guide in the caves will give you a magic ring. If you wear it to the third finger of your right hand, you can travel in space by chanting the Gayatri Mantra.



You can take the big box with you through space distributing the palm-leaf manuscripts in required number at Avanti, Varanasi, Srinagar, Kanchi and Agastya's Ashram. #



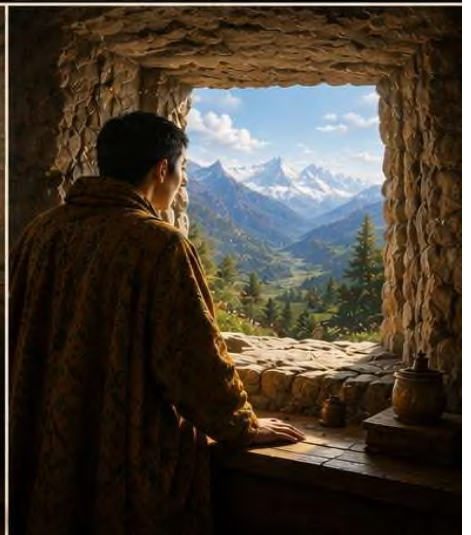
Until you complete our work, you will be sleeping during the day in the cave and conducting space travel with your box during the night.

When can I meet you again?

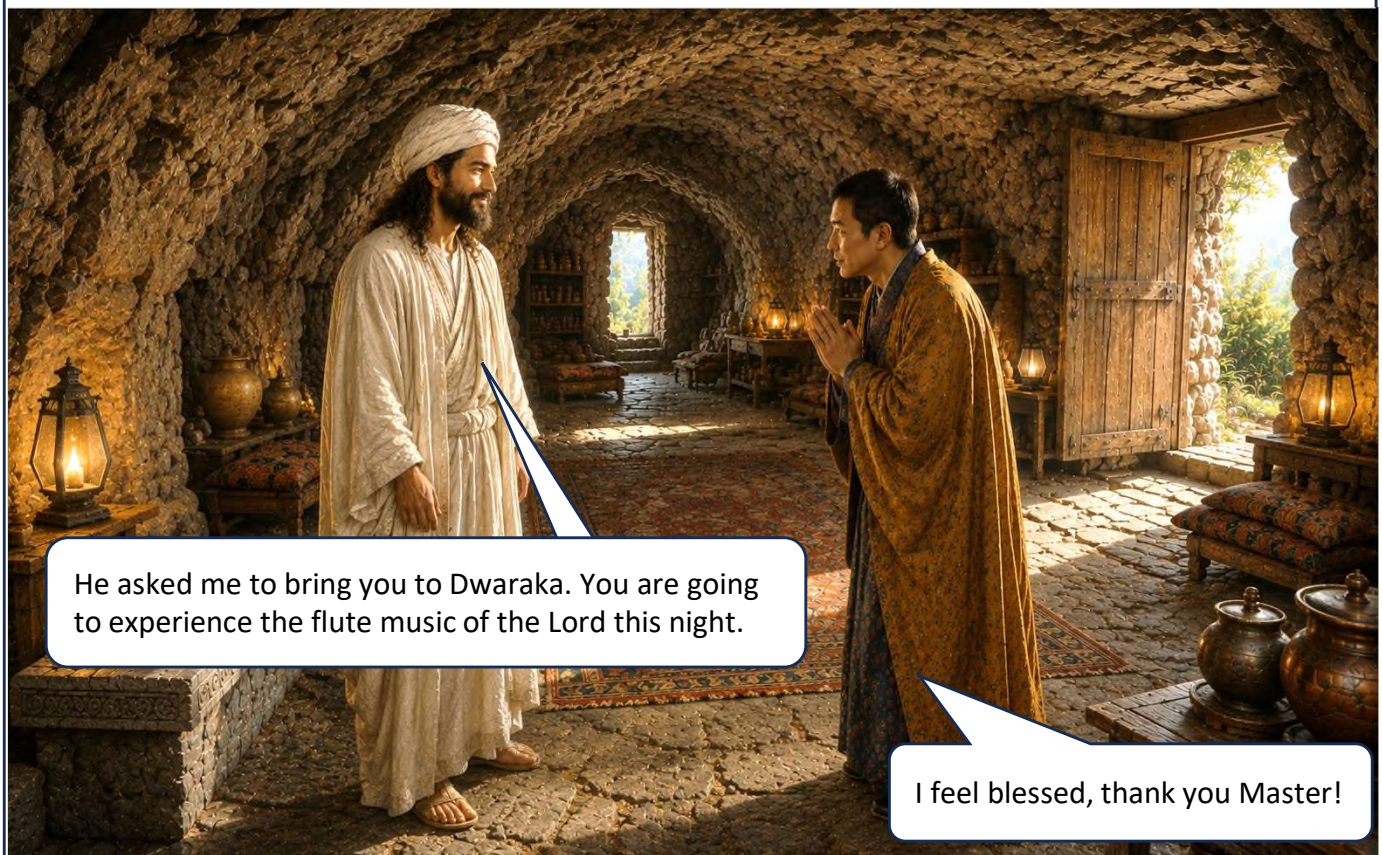

To enjoy the physical proximity of the Lord, Maru tells him that they would walk invisibly.

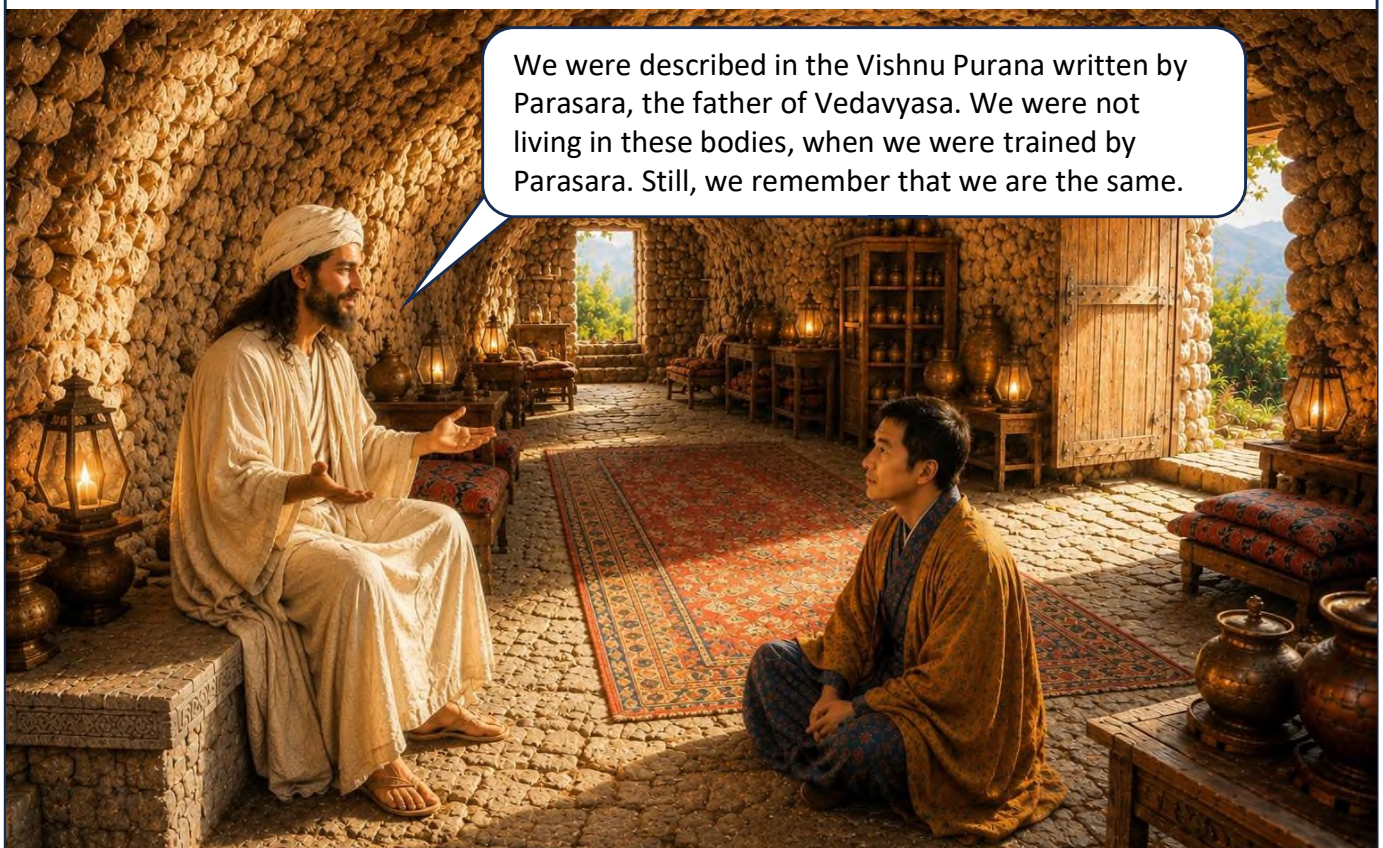
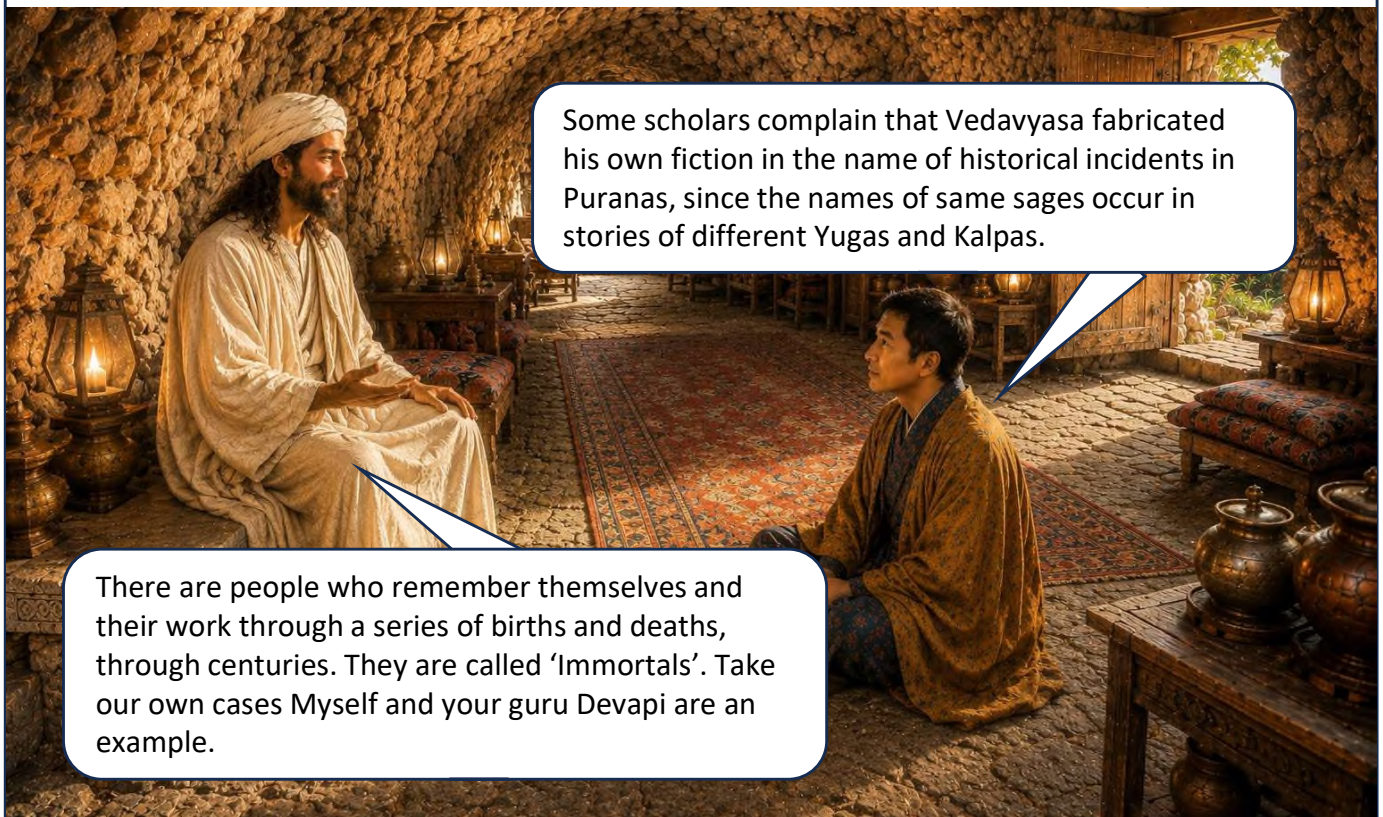

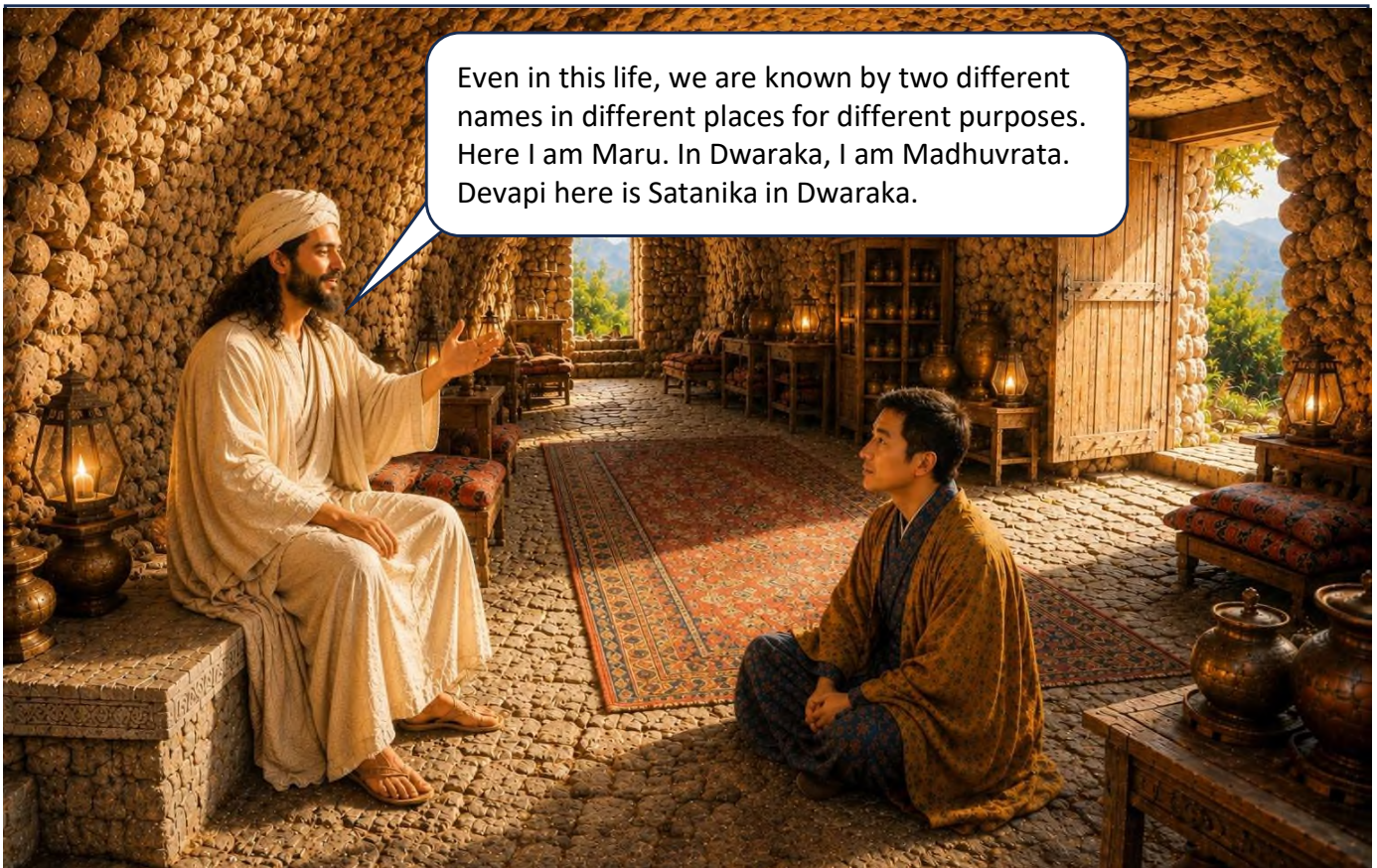


As he passed nearby, the Lord looked into the eyes of Djwhala Khula and smiled. The eyes of Djwhala Khula were filled with tears of joy.



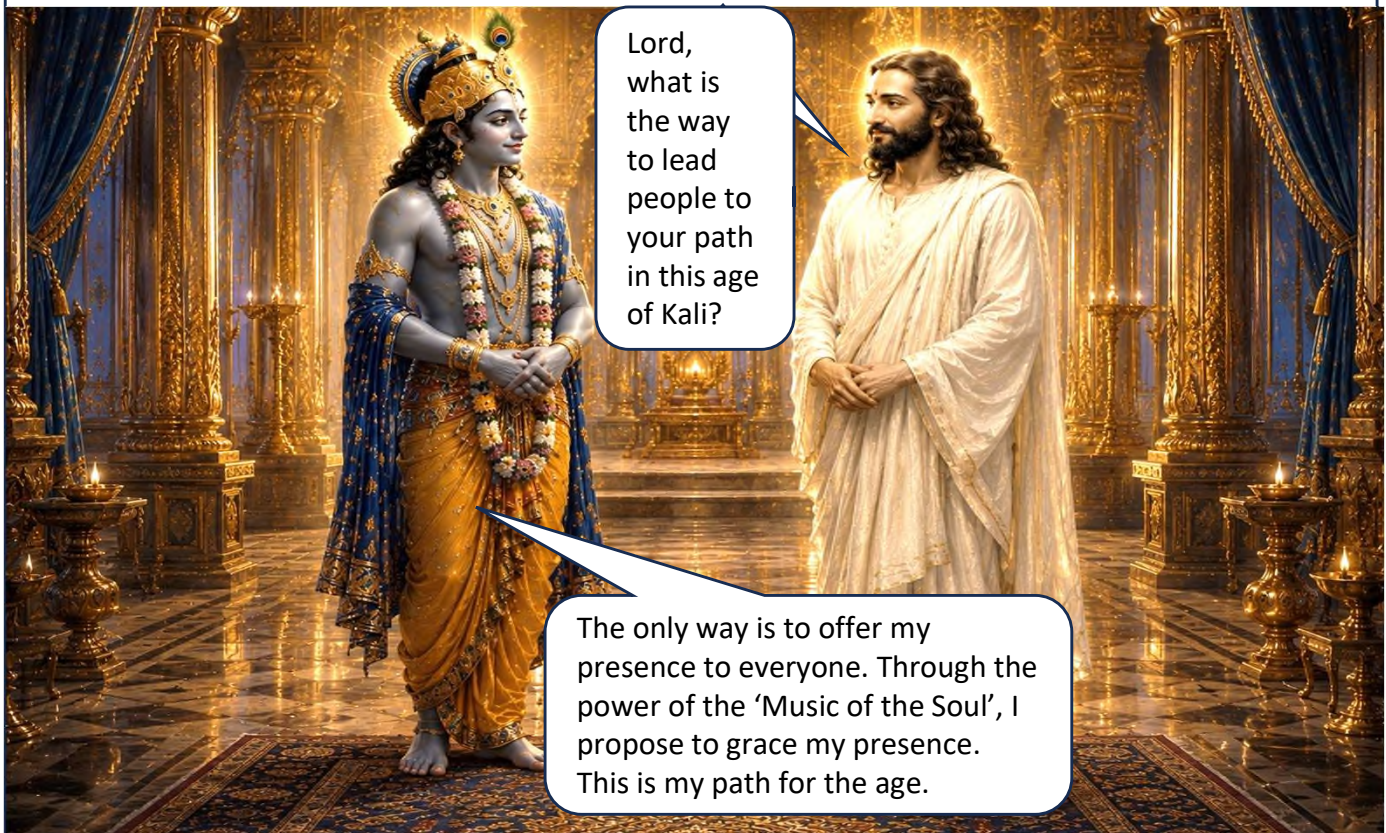

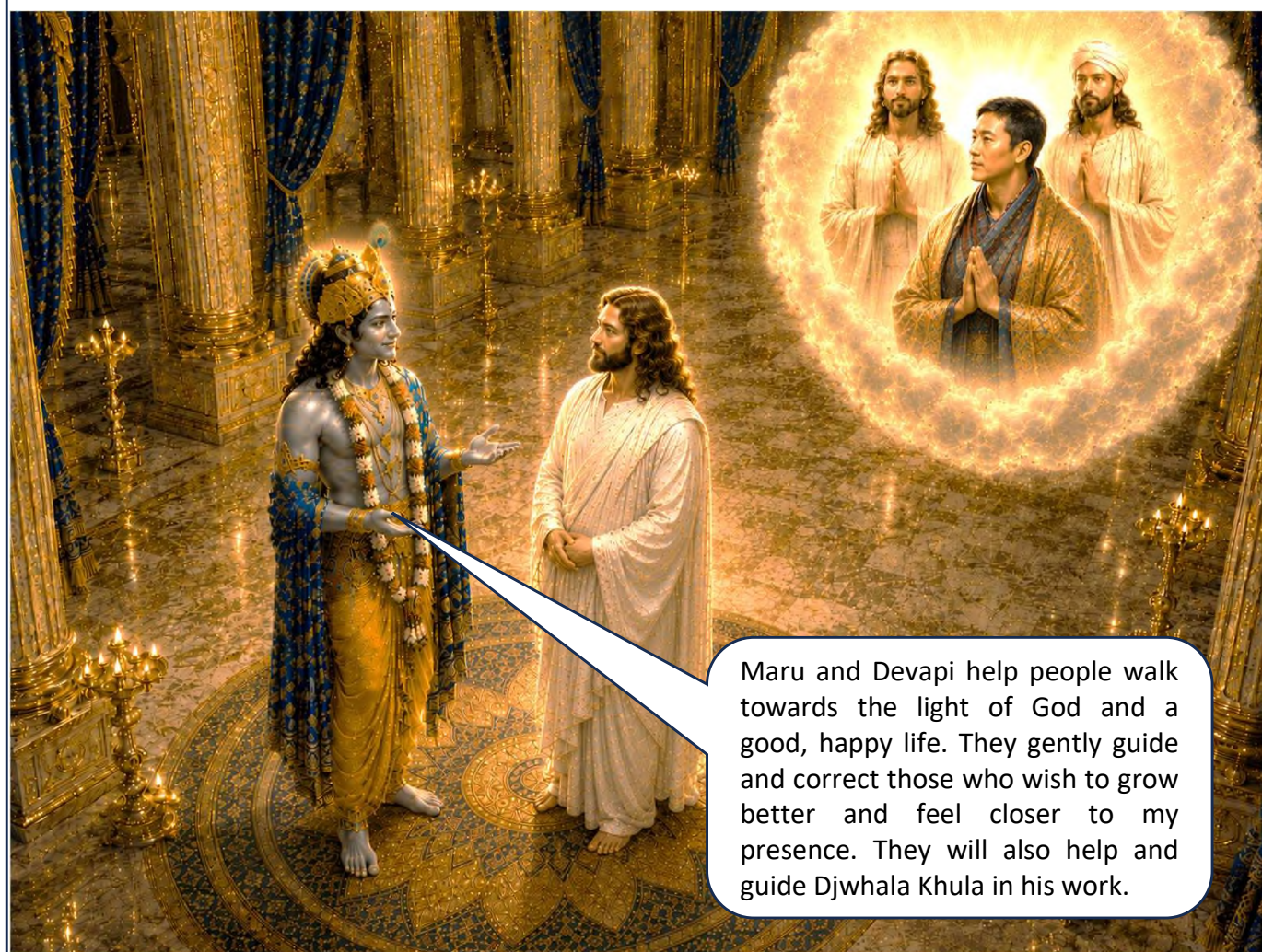

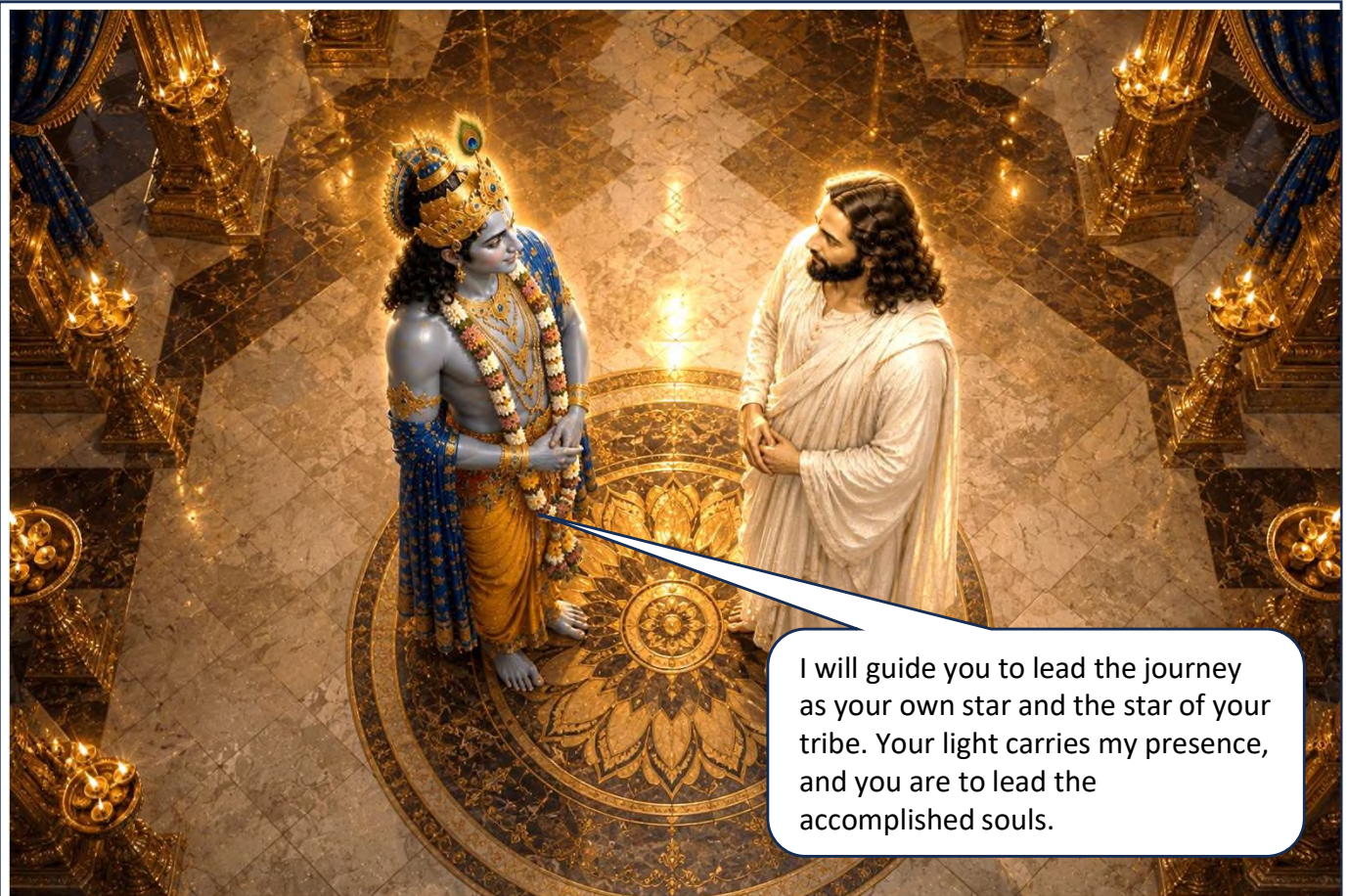


Lord, what is the way to lead people to your path in this age of Kali?

The only way is to offer my presence to everyone. Through the power of the 'Music of the Soul', I propose to grace my presence. This is my path for the age.

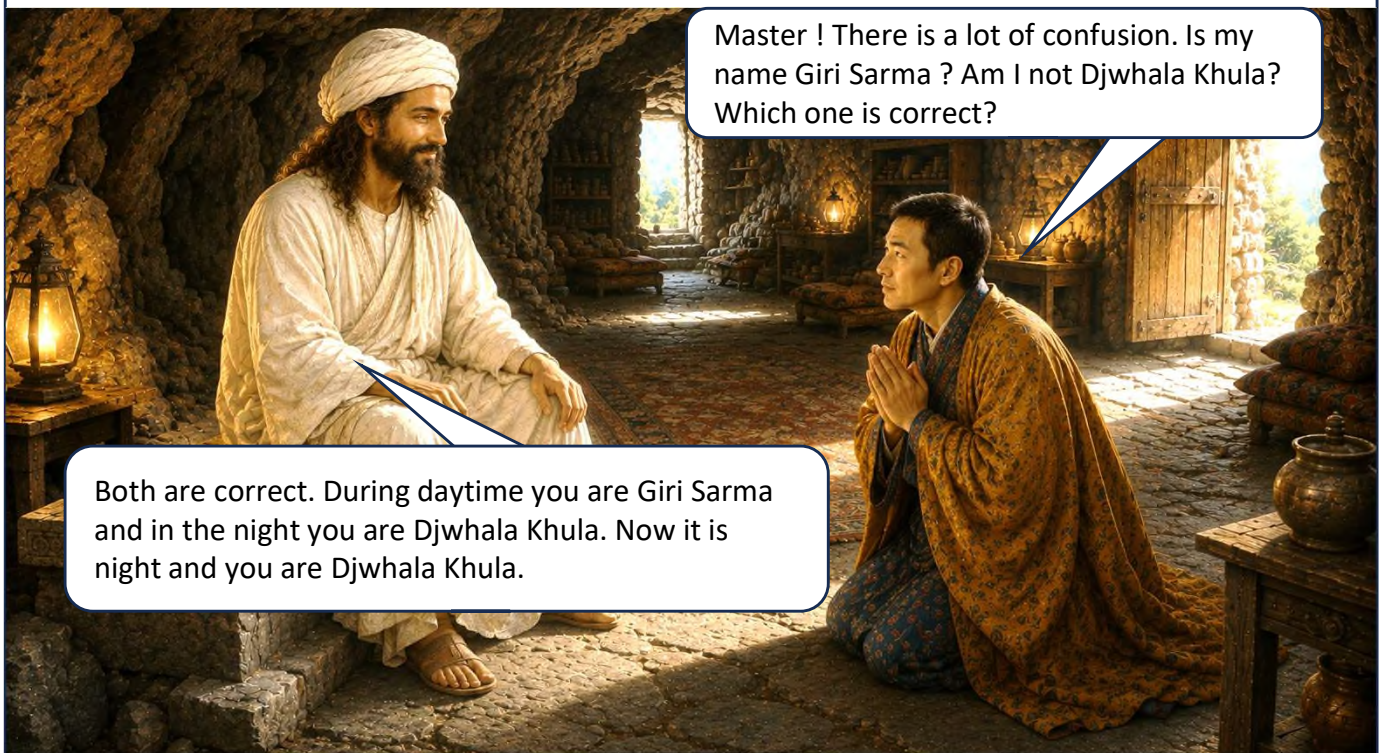
Krishna further says that he continues to give His presence and awaken the seekers through the soul of an accomplished being.

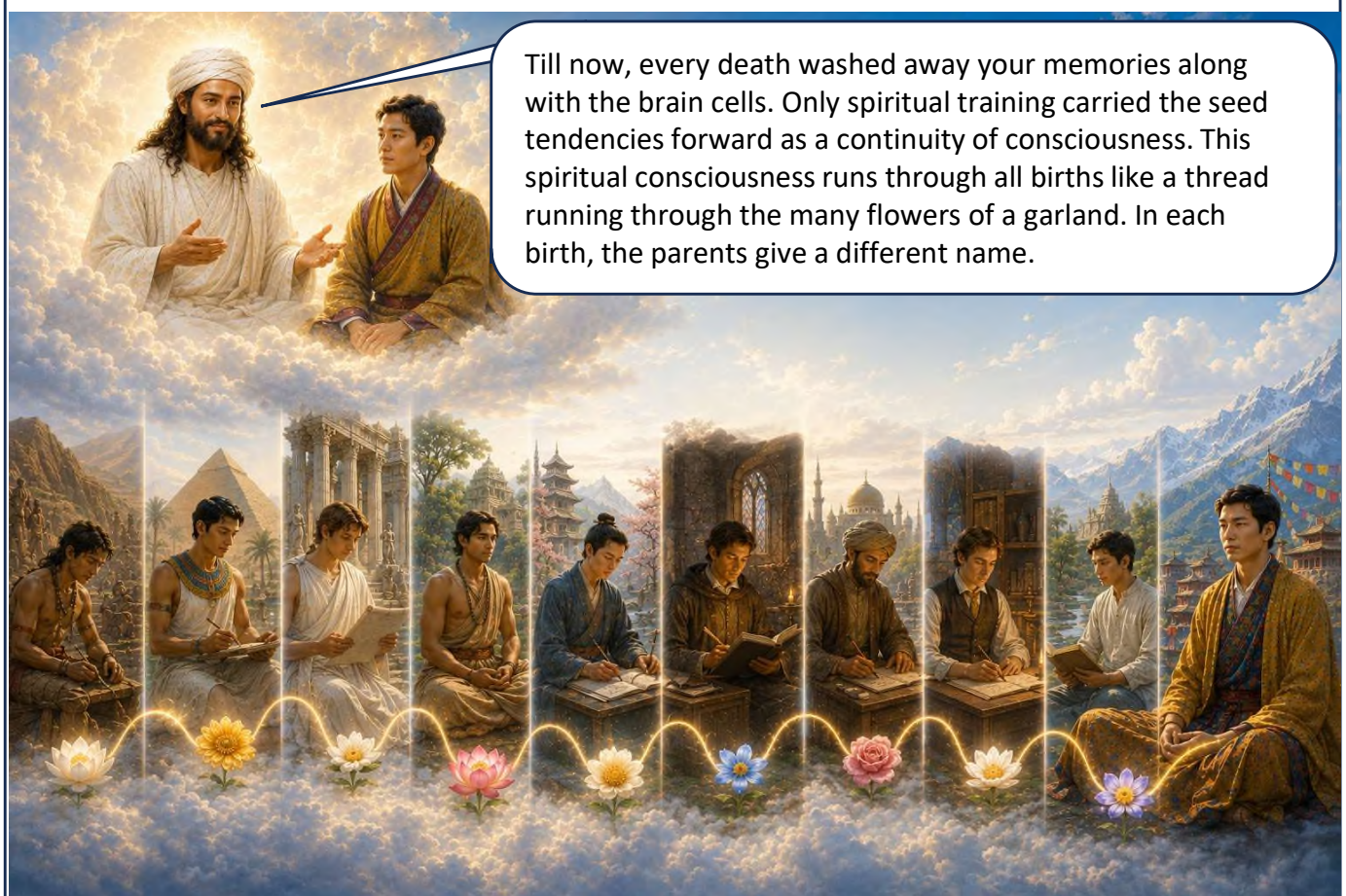


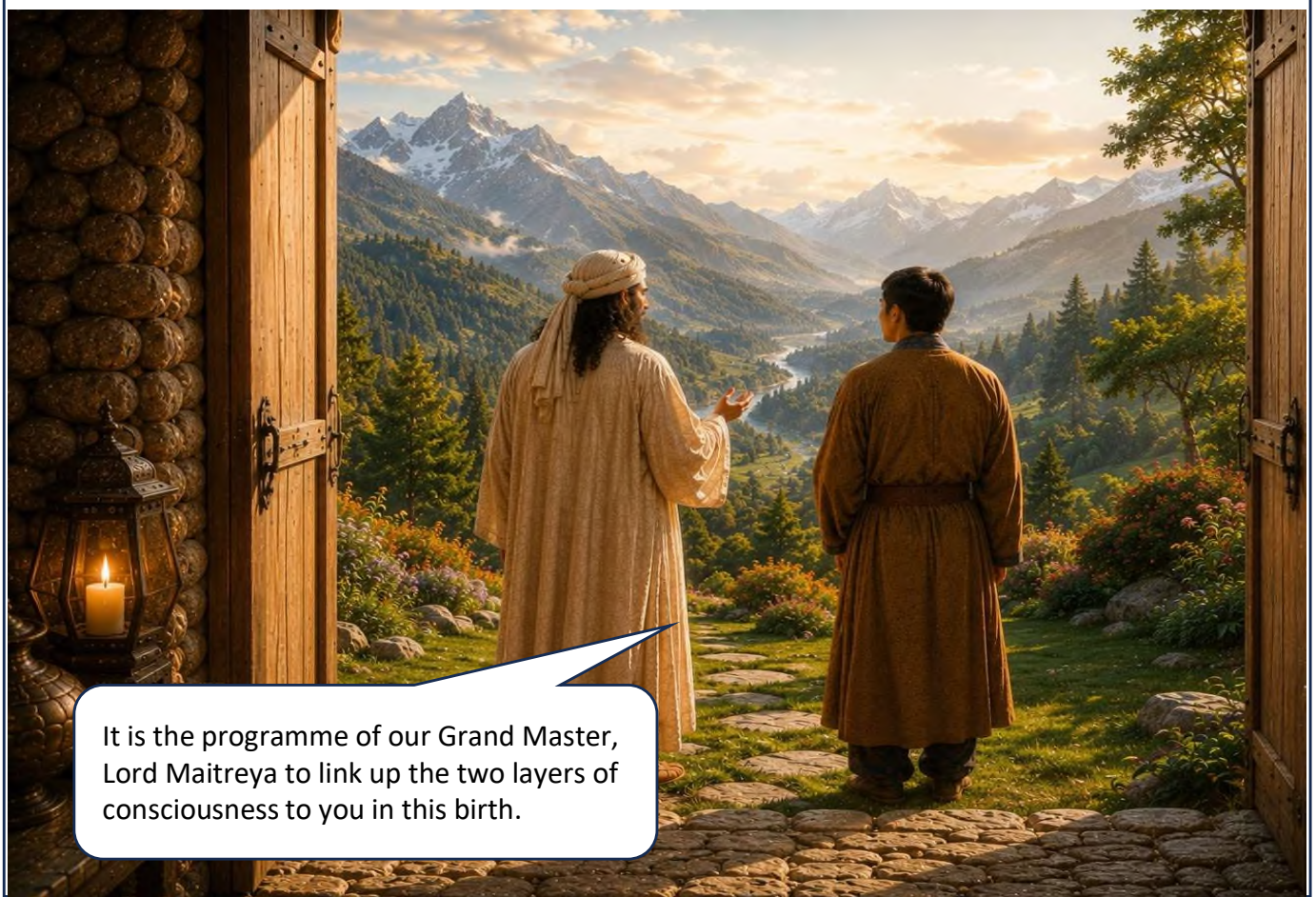
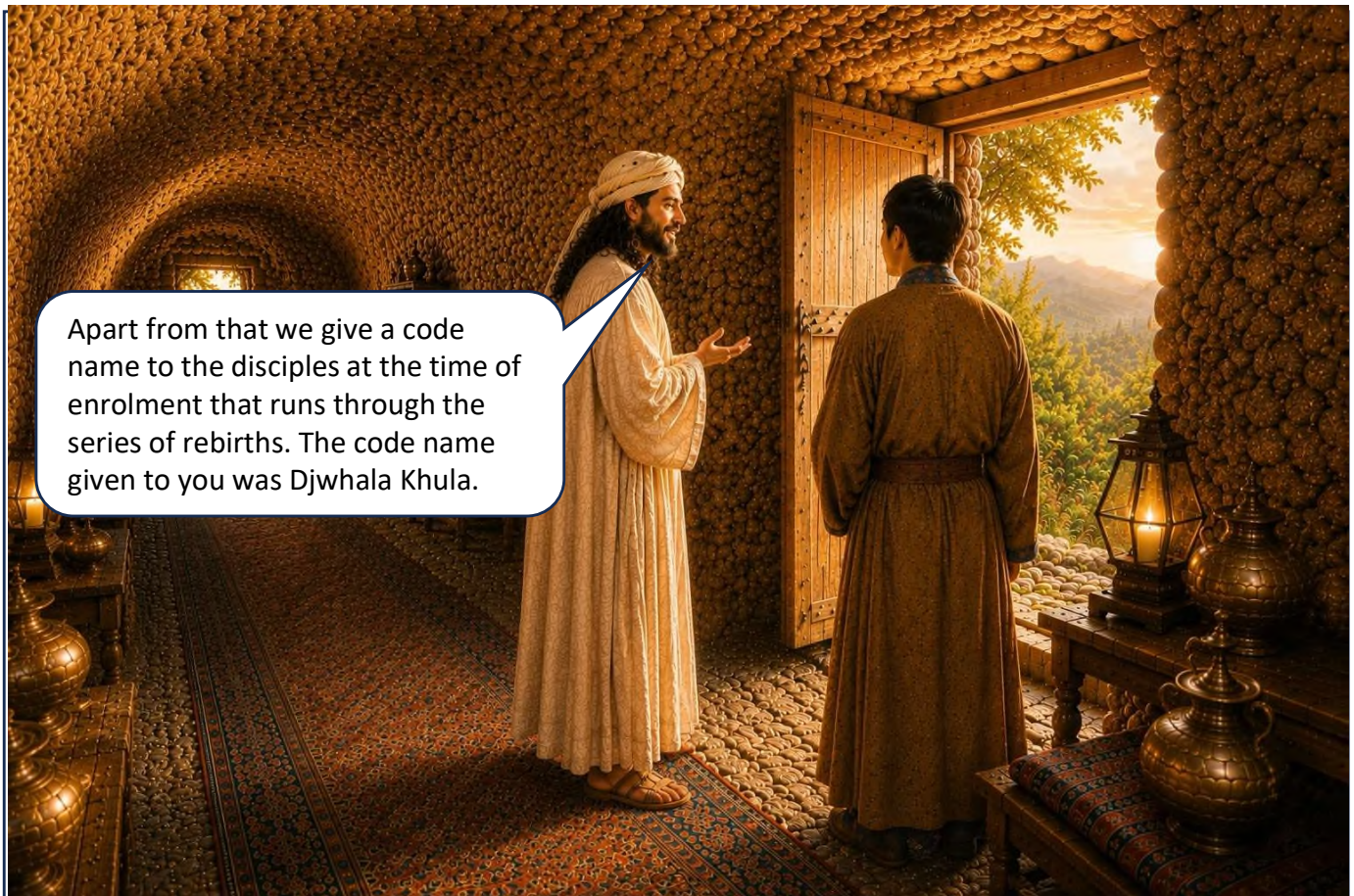
Master ! There is a lot of confusion. Is my name Giri Sarma ? Am I not Djwhala Khula? Which one is correct?

Immediately Djwhala Khula was able to remember all events of his life as Giri Sarma and at the same time he could remember his name was Djwhala Khula.



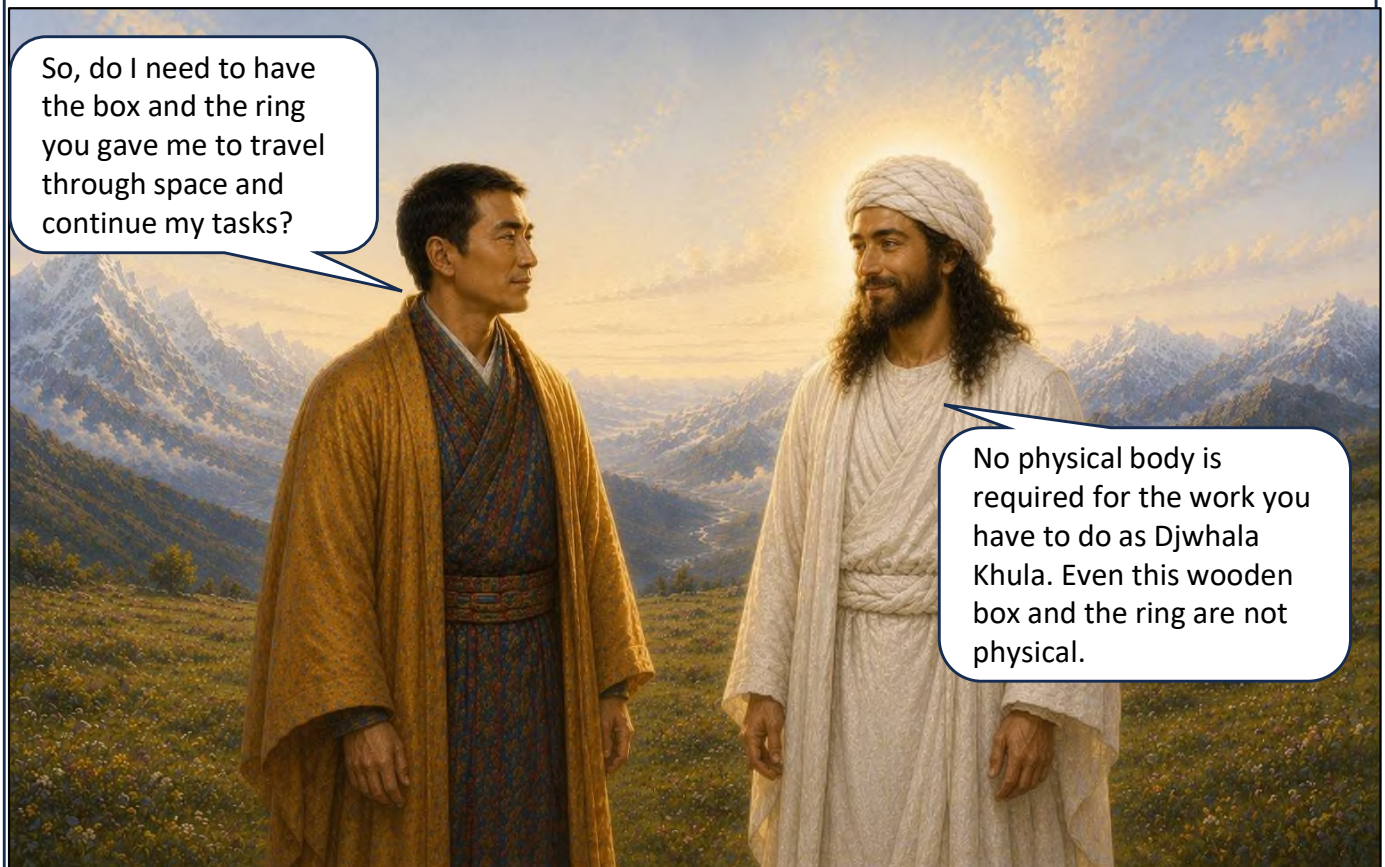






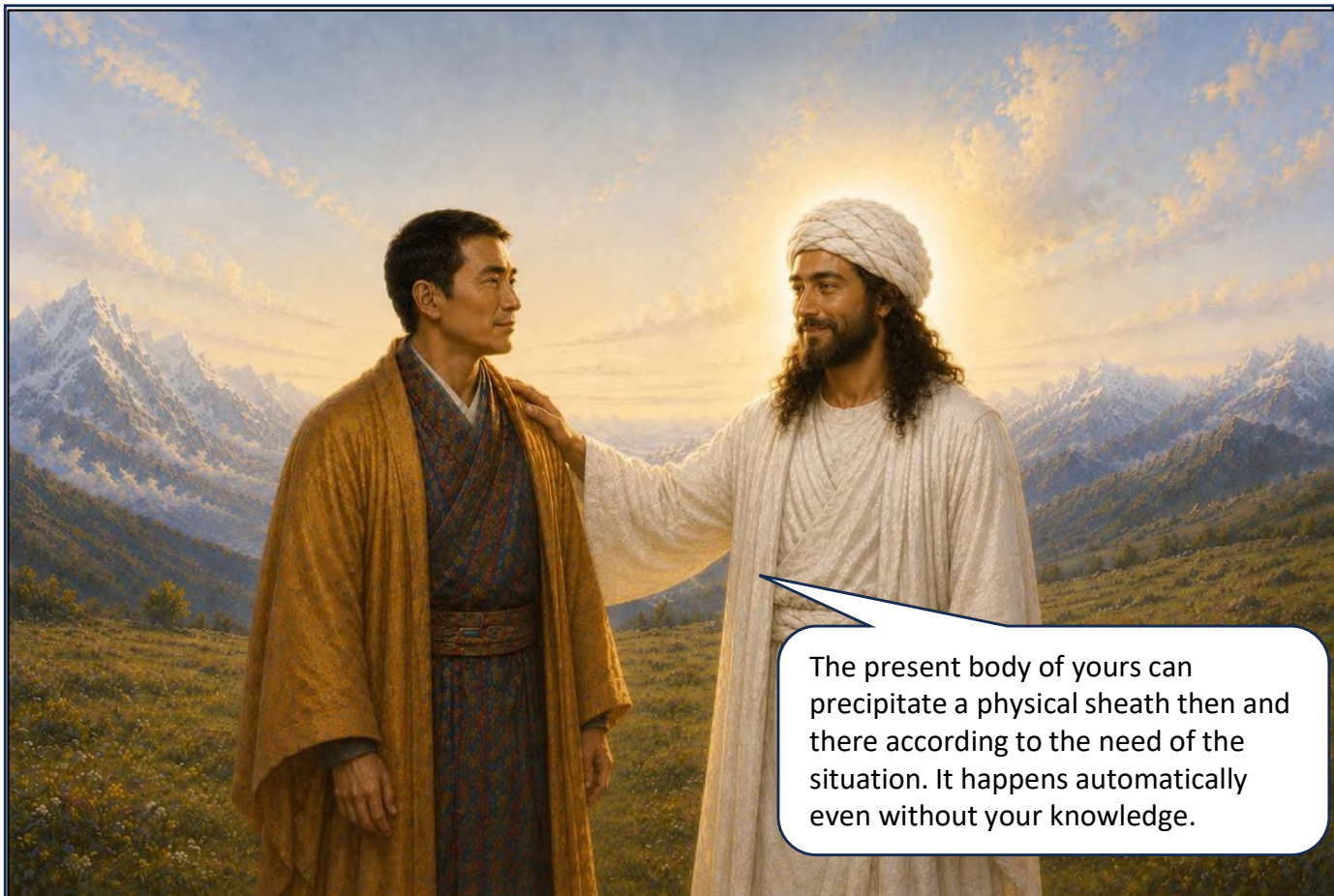

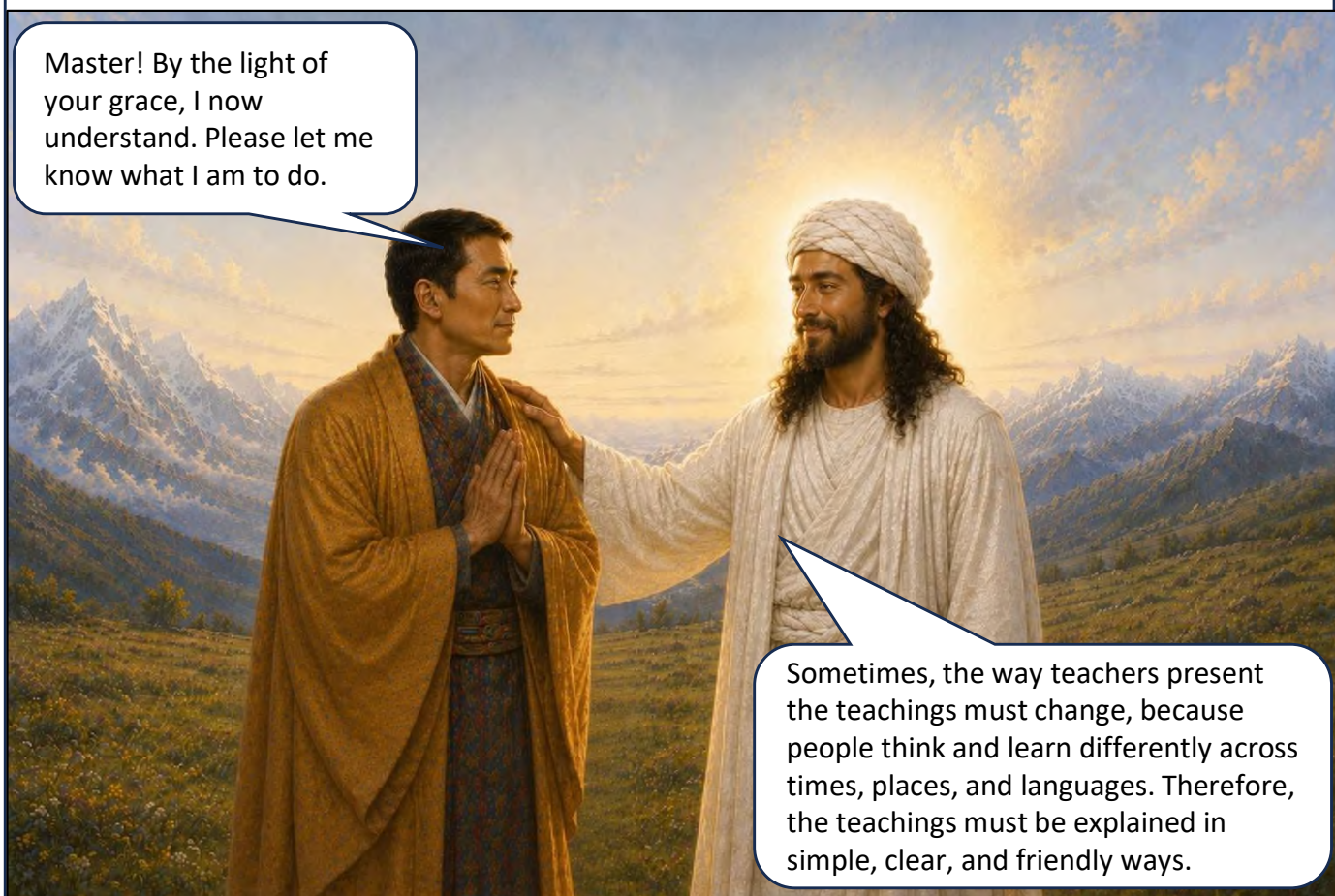


So, do I need to have the box and the ring you gave me to travel through space and continue my tasks?

No physical body is required for the work you have to do as Djwhala Khula. Even this wooden box and the ring are not physical.

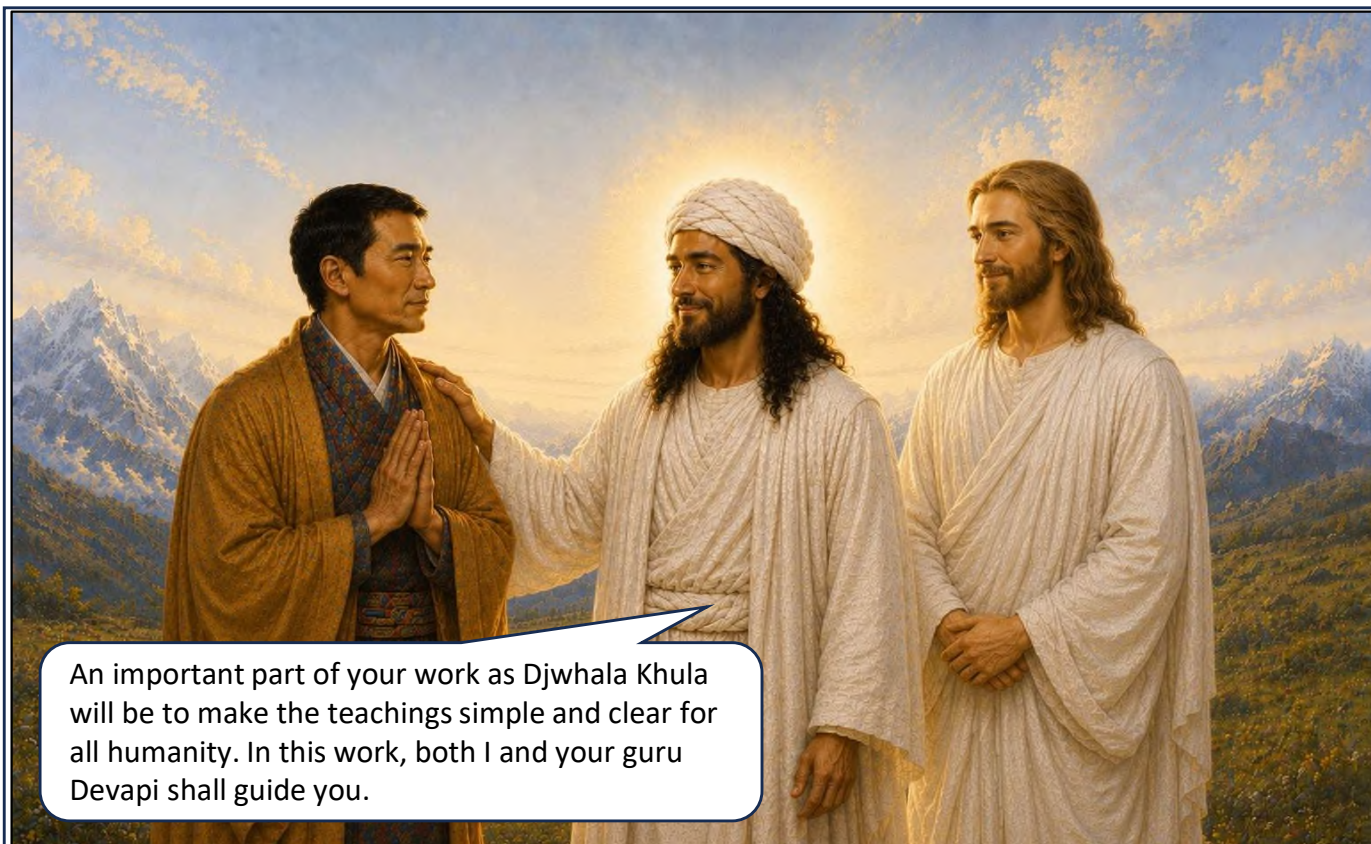


The present body of yours can precipitate a physical sheath then and there according to the need of the situation. It happens automatically even without your knowledge.

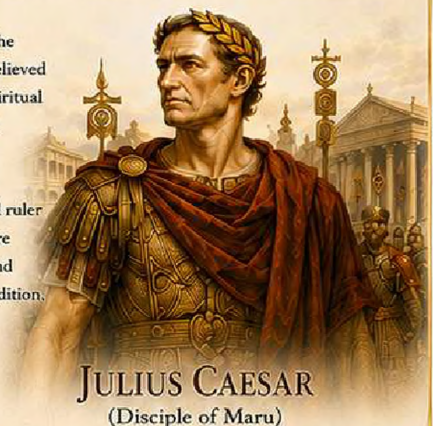
MARU AND THE ROMAN EMPIRE

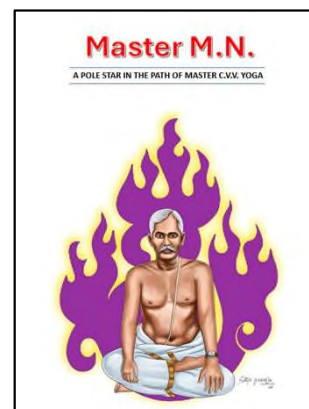
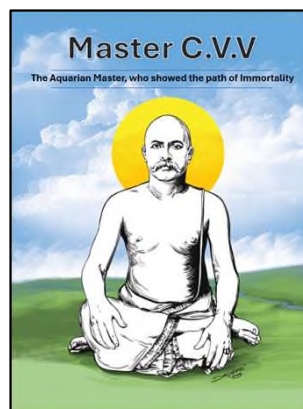
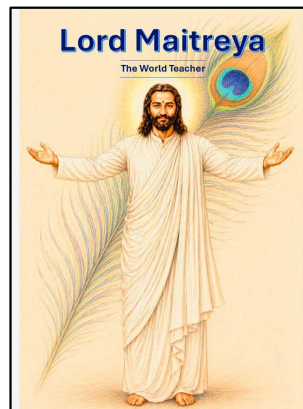
Master Morya and Master Koot Hoomi
