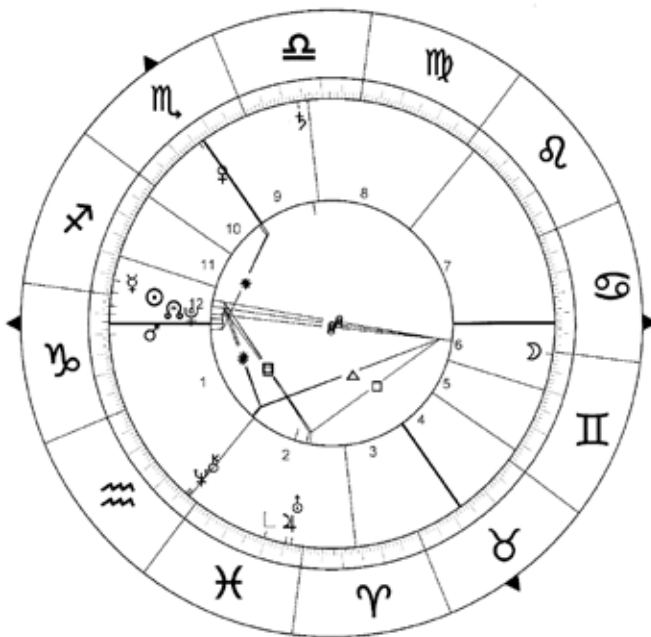

Commentary

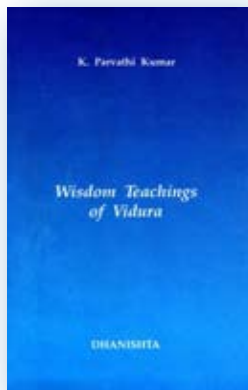
The Unbound

Commentary:

Matter, Mind, Master can also be understood as Matter, Man, Master. These are the three states of the one journey. Once creation is completed, the beginning of the evolution starts from matter. Matter evolves through forms. The beings are the indwellers of the forms. As the forms evolve, the beings experience better. The experience is optimum in the form of man. The man further evolves as the Master. The evolution is complete. Each time a creation happens, the beings enter into the creation at different levels of evolution. This depends upon the evolution that the beings already accomplished in the previous chain of evolution. Some beings start from the beginning depending upon their previous state of evolution. Some start as plants, some others as animals, still others as human. A few would already have been Masters. The Masters would also come back to help the fellow beings. They are called Kumaras. They form the North Pole (Sahasrara). Their disciples permeate up to Anahata, depending upon their evolution.

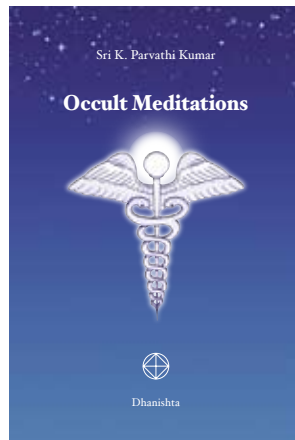
The aspirants are just above the equator and the worldly man is in solar plexus. Solar plexus is the equator. Depending upon the evolution of the worldly man, he permeates between the solar plexus and the lower Muladhara. Below the lower Muladhara, subhuman beings exist up to gross matter.

Man has an option to move upwards towards the North Pole from the

equator by following the path of Yoga (discipleship). He can also tread the path of worldliness and get into centres lower than the solar plexus. He therefore is at the midway point and is therefore the equator.

When man becomes a Master, he also works out another equation, a new balance. This is the higher equator namely the heart centre (Anahata). Staying in the heart, a Master handles the higher and the lower forces. He balances them in him. He moves with facility in the field of Spirit and matter. He also forms the bridge between the higher beings and the worldly beings. He further becomes a path for the lower beings to pass over to the higher circles. The whole path of evolution is a movement from gross to subtle, from matter to Spirit and thereafter settle in the midway point.

The student of meditation is recommended to visualise the light from Sahasrara to Anahata and to further visualise such light reflecting below the diaphragm to ensure that the darkness relating to the illusion of the world is dispelled up to the Muladhara.

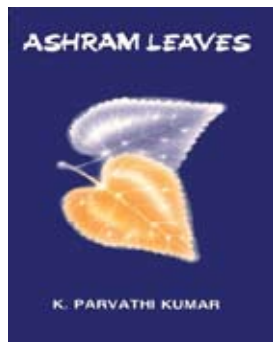




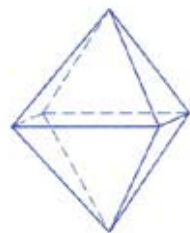

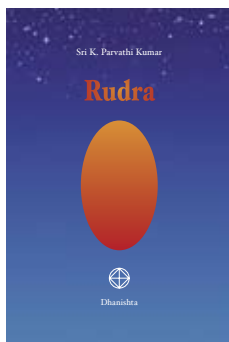


Rudra

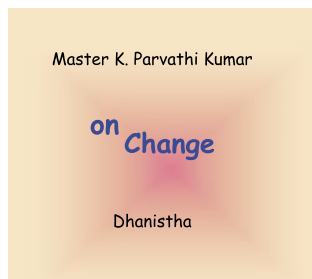

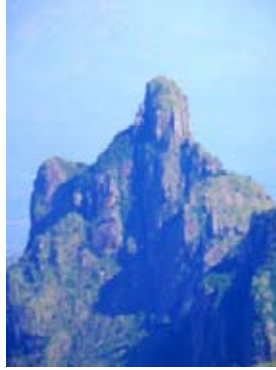

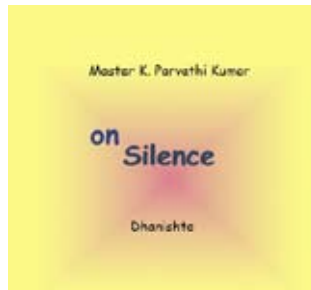

Oh Lord Agni! The one who is wealthy and strong and who does not offer through ritual prayers to you would gradually become poor and weak. His wealth disappears, his strength decays gradually. The darkness of ignorance shrouds his intellect and he turns out to be diabolic. Knowing this, one shall not deviate from his prayers to you.

Commentary:

There is fire in us and fire around. Cognition of fire and its work within oneself and in the surrounding is the first step. Maintaining the fire in the body, which exists as fire of assimilation of food, fire of aspiration, fire of mind, needs to be maintained if not improved upon through an attitude of reverence to fire. When offerings are made to others cognising existence of fire in others, fire is pleased. When offerings are also made through fire ritual, fire is pleased. When sacred word is uttered regularly, fire is pleased. When one does not cognise fire and not worship it and even does not be grateful to it, one cannot aspire to grow harmoniously. The wealth that he holds gives not happiness to him. Even if he is powerful the power does not bestow the related peace, poise, and harmony. He would even be tempted to utilise the power and money in an unlawful manner. Many well-meaning people growing in wealth and strength turn out to be diabolic when such wealth and strength are not shared with the surrounding life. Such is the Law. For this reason the worshipper is cautioning through this hymn not to be distant to the fire.

Jâts and their origin..

The Râjâ and ninety-nine percent of the inhabitants (of Râjasthân) are Jâts. One thing is certain: the Jâts are one of the most ancient people of India and, although “aborigines” to the Râjputs who came after them, are not the actual aborigines, but are themselves newcomers in respect to the real aborigines...

Under the “beneficent rule of England” (a stereotyped expression), a large part of Râjasthân has now mixed within itself pure Râjputs and Jâts, and their thâkurs and zamindârs enjoy equal rights or, what is perhaps more true, equally do not enjoy any rights outside those of the average landowner and proprietor of his own estate. Public opinion, however, which rarely errs, has dug an impassable chasm between the Thâkurs of Râjput and those of Jât blood. The Jât Thâkur is a feudal baron who plunders by night. The Râjput Thâkur is a knight, un chevalier sans peur et sans reproche, in the full sense of the word. In order to appease the former and thus provide itself with faithful allies, the government while forbidding plunder by day, de jure, has permitted it de facto, having allowed the plunderers, like the Bedouin sheiks in Palestine and Syria, to collect indemnity from the incoming caravans and travellers, in order to guarantee the latter full safety from the Bhîls. But the Râjput Thâkurs did not accept a single one of the favors offered them. Ruling and governing almost autocratically a handful of their own subjects, they practically never ride beyond the boundaries of their village and, frequently, not even beyond those of their castles. CHAPTER V

The Creation of the Mental Beings

Maitreya questioned: "Now you have described the coming down of your creation. Now tell me elaborately about the creation of the mental beings: how were created the classification and the qualities that are classified? How the Karma of the classes of human beings like the Brahmins, etc., was made?"

Parasara explained: "The Creator uttered forth what came to Him as urge. This He called Truth. From this He has created the satwic beings. From His bosom He created the affectionate beings which are rajasic by nature. From His thighs (the region of His genitals) He has expressed the creation which is emotional, being an admixture of Rajas and Tamas. From His feet He made the creation of Tamas (unconscious, inanimate and static). This is the four-fold classification of beings.

The first group is called Brahmanas (aware of Brahma), the second group is called Kshatrias (the instinct of protection), the third group is called Vaisyas (reciprocation or supplementation), the fourth group is called Sudras (those of the physical plane). Thus they are born from the mouth, the chest, the thighs and the feet.

Seminar in Belgium



From Friday late afternoon (25th of June) until Sunday early afternoon (27th of June), the White Lotus Group (Louvain, Belgium) had the pleasure to gather with other spiritual companions and, together, enjoy Master K. Parvathi Kumar's presence.

Soon after the Master and his close "traveling group's" arrival, the community gathered and meditated. The day after (on Saturday, the 25th) started around 6AM for the morning prayer. After this, the Master undertook an open session where everyone was invited to ask one's personal questions or asked some guidance on more general issues. Some aspirant wondered about their own personal orientation while "walking the spiritual path" and Master Kumar gently answered her that all Masters act according to the aspirant's needs. If this is material, then the help will be material. If it related to more spiritual expectations (i.e, self-realization, self-knowledge), then the Master's energy will support such a dynamic. Other questions were related to the "ego" and its "location" in the body. The question was answered with "the ego has no specific location in the body for it is more a question of consciousness". The ego exists as long as the consciousness of separativity remains. The Master also demonstrated His ability to go beyond religions had been perfectly demonstrated while carefully understanding and answering each person's desires despite individual affiliations.

The day went on and it was time for all the participants to enjoy a nice lunch. Later, the group visited Brussels until late afternoon and gathered again for the evening prayer and lunch.

On Sunday, the group had the great chance to attend and take part in Pierre and Marie's marriage. Their marriage ceremony was celebrated with a fire ritual. Everyone has experienced the genuine and pure emotions underlying such a marriage.

Very logically, the Master offered us profound and detailed teachings about the importance of marriage. He insisted that this union (that we can consider as a life-long yoga) is the highest and most sacred sacrament that humans are allowed to "perform". Later, he insisted on the need to educate oneself if one wants to educate others: "Everything starts in one's own house with oneself, with one's children, with one's family, friends, colleagues, community, etc." He carefully warned us about the risk associated to mentalism: "Theories can be the worse toys of the mind. They are not meant to spoil one's life on them for they are meant to open up to the subjective dimension of reality." He insisted on the necessity to achieve the development of the 5 upper petals of our lotus flower and, with this purpose in mind, mentioned the relevance of pranayama.

In short, the group experienced three intensive and joyful days. Fire rituals, meditations, wonderful meals, authentic marriage (both in its ceremonial aspect and in the union of Pierre and Marie). We were all very pleased to experience these days. So were the doves.

The Nature and the Characteristics
Of the World Mother, Part XXXVI

Tenth Hymn

To please a woman a man often says, "Wouw, you look so young!" Which lady would like to listen that she is old? People use varieties of ways to please. To please is a good quality, but to use the untruth to please is manipulation. It may not cause a negative impact on the other, but you get habituated to speak that which is not true. That is dangerous. Not knowing we try to be untruthful in our utterances in our endeavour to please people. While we are recommended to be pleasant in our speech, we need not sacrifice truth in the process of being pleasant, and we need not be unpleasant to present the truth. There can be many bitter truths, but you should have the technique to quote it sweet and present it. That is the way it has to be done. Then you are not hurting the other being, and yet you are not sacrificing the truth. People either are bitter or untruthfully pleasant. They are pleasant but not truthful – unpleasant but truthful. Both have not gained the Mother.

There is a pleasant way of putting forth truth. This is a discipline that one has to consciously work out and gain. It is no necessity to speak untruth for the sake of being pleasant. In every person there is something that can be seen as positive, and that can be truthfully expressed. Then you are pleasing the person and not speaking the untruth. This is how the observation of the divinity in the other becomes possible. Each one carries one skill or the other which is positive, and no one is totally positive without some negatives or deficiencies. People have efficiencies, people have deficiencies. You have to speak the efficiency part that opens the door with the other, and be friendly. In friendliness moderately the truth can be shared. That is what the Masters keep telling us. See the positive

in the other, and interact with that positive in the other. By that you have gained friendliness, and you can also show your silence to the other side which is not positive in him. This is easier said than done. Normally we only speak of that which is deficient in the other, because our orientation is towards the negative things but not to the positive things.

Here practice of speech is seen as worship of the Mother, because the Word is the Mother, the light. In the second hymn we have known how the Word emerges. Manipulation of the Word manipulates you. So, speak truth, speak truth pleasantly, speak not truth unpleasantly, speak not untruth pleasantly, and speak not untruth. These are the statements through which a process of worship is developed and by which the Word in you is not continuously manipulated. This is a practice by which you can keep yourself eligible for the approach of the presence of light or the divinity. The other is to keep observing the desires and the kind of inquisitiveness that sprouts from within as the Mother.

We are inquisitive about things which are not necessary. If two friends of mine are speaking, I have nothing to do with it. But the inquisitiveness is that we listen to it which is not desirable from the spiritual discipline. Not only we listen, we try to get into it. This is called 'poking one's nose into others' affairs'. Somehow we are not happy unless we also get into it and become part of it. It is a fundamental law in the spiritual field: If three persons are there, two are talking to each other, the nature does not intend the third person to get into it. When the third person is also invited into the conversation, then he should join. Otherwise it is not supposed to join, and in advanced states it is supposed not to listen. This is a discipline. If this is not followed, we have problems, because what the nature intends to conduct shall have to be always keenly observed. When you don't observe, you will walk into problems.

Health & Healing

Prana – Reception, Assimilation
and Circulation

The ABC of bodily health is wrapped up in the right reception of prana, its assimilation and distribution to the physical body. Man has to make basic changes to ensure these three aspects of the work of prana. The centres whereby the reception of prana is brought about must be allowed to function without impediment.

Pranic emanations from the sun are absorbed by the etheric centres, which are found principally in the upper part of the body, such as the forehead, the shoulder blades, and the centre above the diaphragm. From these centres they are directed to the etheric spleen and from the etheric spleen to the spleen of the physical body. The main centre for the reception of prana at present is the centre between the shoulder blades. Other centres of reception are dormant, owing to centuries of wrong living and basic mistakes in relation to natural way of life. The three pranic centres of reception are not in good working order. Only the centre between the shoulder blades is in best receptive condition. Even this receptivity is disturbed, owing to poor condition of the spinal column. In most of the cases, the alignment of the spinal column is not accurate and is slightly misplaced. While the receptive centres of prana are thus functioning in the sub-normal level, the spleen of man is also not adequately developed. Its size today is sub-normal and its vibration is not considered adequate in the esoteric circles.

Where the life is led more normally and naturally, where the upper part of the physical body is adequately exposed to the golden rays of dawn

and dusk sun, and where man is not a slave of physical comforts, there better conditions are found for reception and assimilation of prana. The aboriginal dwellers seem to carry more effective etheric centres than the civilised man. The civilised man's life conditions are far from natural and normal.

In the coming times, the necessity of exposing the centre between the shoulder blades and the centre above the diaphragm to the rays of the sun will be more appreciated. This exposure improves the physical vitality and makes man adaptable to the changing weathers.

It must be remembered that reception of prana is to enable such prana to interact with the latent heat existing in the physical body cells. When prana functions through the etheric centres adequately, it cooperates with the natural latent bodily warmth, holding the body in a vitalised condition. It imposes upon the matter of the body, giving the required rate of vibration, leading to the healthy functioning of the body organs.

The pranic heat purifies the cell matter, reduces their density, enabling healthy contact between the latent heat of the cell matter and the active heat of prana. Yoga asanas, exercises, breathing practices, physical exertions – they all help in this direction. They would keep the body agile, active, and healthy. Bodily inertia should therefore be seen by a physician as inactive functioning of the two fires within.

When prana is received by the two etheric centres (the centre between the shoulder blades and the centre above the diaphragm) and distributed to the etheric counterpart of spleen, then the three centres form into a triangle. The pranic fire circulates thrice through this triangle and is supplied thereafter to the physical organ of the spleen. Thereafter the physical prana is transmitted to the base of the spine to link up to the latent heat of the body. When such link up happens adequately, the fire of prana and the heat of the body cure and provide a very healthy condition to man.

This understanding of the occult science could be helpful to open-minded physicians, healers, and health workers.

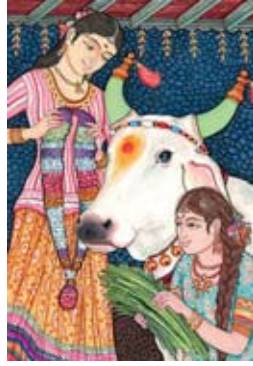

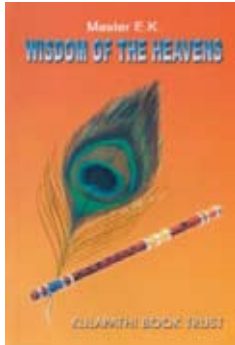
